Beginning Quilting

Learn from beginning to end the techniques and skills needed to create your own quilt. We will work on all aspects of making a small lap quilt from picking fabrics, learning the tools "toys" of the trade, understanding your machine, block assembly and quilt finishing (top may not be finished in class).

A supply list will be provided upon registration, a book with patterns is required for the class and will be available for purchase at the shop.

Class is hands-on instruction in the art of hand applique (limit 4 students per session).

Class Policies:

- Payment is required at the time of registration
- A supply list and special instructions will be given out upon registration
- Most classes require a solid working sewing machine
- It is best if you have your own equipment (rulers, rotary cutter, etc.)
- Our quilt workshops are for piecing the top only
- If you are unable to attend a class, cancellation must be made one week prior to the class. You may apply the fee to
 another class. Failure to notify the shop one week prior will result in forfeiture of class fee. If we cancel a class, you
 will receive a full refund
- As appreciation to our customers, we offer a 10% discount for fabric and supplies purchased for our classes, clubs and workshops
