# Village of Downs FY2027 Events Plan

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## *Summary*

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This following document provides an overview and budget of the planned events for the Village of Downs. This plan was developed and approved by the Events Committee to be submitted, for review, by the Village Board in April for each fiscal year. Once approved by the Village Board the budget will be tracked in a dedicated Events Fund recording all income and expenses for each event.

Solicitation of volunteers for the sub-committees will be put into the Village flyer and Events Facebook page as needed. The Event Committee would like to ask the Village Board to be involved and support at least one or more events. Sub-committees will be responsible for all aspects of the event in which they represent. The Events Committee reserves the right to run any event without forming a sub-committee and to cancel an event due to lack of help.

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## *Mission*

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The mission of the Events Committee is to provide a mix of events within the Village of Downs that will attract surrounding communities into the Village of Downs.

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## *Goals and Objectives*

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1. Form an Event Committee made up of Downs and Tri-Valley community members to prepare and perform the following:
  - Create and submit, for Board approval in April each fiscal year, a plan of events and budget
  - Create events that will be self-sustaining through donations, sponsors, and other event revenue without the use of taxpayer dollars.
  - Solicit volunteers and form sub-committees for events as warranted. The Events Committee may decide to perform or run events themselves without creating a sub-committee.
  - Oversee the execution of events and modify or delete events as warranted.
2. Solicit tax-deductible donations, sponsors, and advertising to aide in funding 4<sup>th</sup> of July celebration.

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## *Fiscal Year Events*

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The following describes each planned event at a high level. Further details and changes will occur during final planning by the committee or sub-committee in charge of the event. Budgets have been estimated based on last year's expenditures and revenue. Some events have been eliminated due to lack of participation, or they were merged with something else.

1. ***Dooley Park Cruise-In*** – This event will be held Saturday June 7<sup>th</sup> in Dooley Park from 3 – 7 pm. There will be no rainout date.
2. ***Village Cleanup Day*** – This event will be held on the first Saturday in June each year. We hope to have containers for garbage, recycle, electronics, batteries, tires (extra fee). Home pick up can be arranged for a donation.
3. ***Freedom Run*** – The Freedom Run will be held June 28<sup>th</sup> and is a 5K Run, 1 Mile Walk & Kids Fun Run held at Tri-Valley Middle School & High School. This event is looking for a new coordinator.
4. ***4<sup>th</sup> of July*** – This event will be the first of two large events for the Village. This year will be a one-day event.
5. ***Downs Haunted House*** – This event will be the second of the two large events. This event will be every Friday and Saturday in October until Halloween. The Un-Haunted House for kids will be on the last Sunday in October.
6. ***Cookies with Santa*** – This very popular family-oriented event providing free picture(s) with Santa for the family and/or kids, cookies, and drinks. The event will take place the first Saturday and Sunday in December. Session dates and times to be announced later.
7. ***Easter Egg Hunt*** – This event will be hosted in Dooley Park on Saturday March 28, 2026. The area Churches will coordinate the egg hunt and the events committee will host the family breakfast before the egg hunt. Location is TBD.

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## *Advertisements, Sponsors and Donations*

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An annual donation solicitation letter will be used to ask area towns, residents, and businesses for advertising, sponsorships, and donations. An advertising booklet will be used for 4<sup>th</sup> of July, Freedom Run, and the Haunted House. The Events Committee uses various methods of advertising for the events throughout the year as the budget allows and is not limited to radio, newspaper, flyers, newsletters, mailers, Spotify, and banners.

## *Event Details*

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A summary of the events budget can be found in Appendix A of this plan. Individual budgets are not included.

*Dooley Park Cruise-In* – This event will be held on the first Saturday in June in Dooley Park from 3 – 7 pm. There isn't a rainout date planned but maybe rescheduled for the fall. A *Cruise-In* is a social gathering of fellow enthusiasts who enjoy the venue and camaraderie. Mid-State Cruisers car club will sponsor and coordinate the cruise-in.

*Village Cleanup Day* – This event will be held on the first Saturday in June from 7 am – 2 pm. The Village will have a location for residents to come drop off items. Location will be at the Village of Downs Police Department at 315 S. Lincoln St. Services will be announced closer to the event, but last year we had garbage, metal, electronics, battery, and tires (extra fee). We will do home pickup, if requested, but ask for a donation to the events fund in return.

*Freedom Run* – The sub-committee are planning to keep the party at the finish line and truly celebrate all participants! We will finish the 5k and 1 mile walk course with a lap around the high school track. New to the Downs Freedom Run? Enjoy one of the flattest 5k courses in the area, with a route that runs through our community with cheering spectators to greet you along the way. Get festive and be ready to have a fun morning - this is one you don't want to miss!

As always, any Downs Freedom Run proceeds are re-invested in the local community. Over the years we have installed a new drinking fountain/water bottle refill station at Dooley Park; provided grants to local, small businesses struggling from COVID-19 impacts; supported the Downs 4th of July celebration; as well as other causes that help our village.

Partial proceeds from the 2025 race will go toward the Downs Fireworks.

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*4<sup>th</sup> of July Celebration* – This event will be the first of two large events for the Village. This year again will be planned as a one-day event but could be expanded based on volunteers and funding.

The Event Committee will ONLY do the following for this event:

- 1) Contract and coordinate fireworks - The Village will use the same company that has been contracted since 2017 and currently under an extended 3-year agreement until 2025. This year's fireworks are \$16,000. Fireworks contract should be signed by March of each year if we don't have a multi-year contract. The payment should be made, if possible, by Dec 31 of the previous year to get the previous year's pricing. The contract cost will be funded through donations, ads, sponsors, fundraisers, and/or admissions.

The 4<sup>th</sup> of July sub-committee will coordinate or eliminate the following depending on volunteers:

- 1) Plan and coordinate the parade - The parade will start at noon and will follow the same parade route as previous years. The park road will be closed after the parade, except for the parking areas. Washington St will also be closed from Lincoln to Woodlawn after the parade until after fireworks. Grand Marshal nominations need to be solicited starting in March thru June 1. If a nominee doesn't have majority of votes, the Village Board of Trustees will make the final decision. Registration is required to get a reserved spot, otherwise participants will be instructed to just get in line. Volunteers are only needed to mark spots for reservations.
- 2) Contact and secure all Food Vendors
- 3) Contact and secure all Entertainment (i.e. Bands) - Bands chosen will be local and which provide quality entertainment at a fair price. We will look to secure a variety of music style to appeal to as many as possible.
- 4) Donations – Solicitation letter must be sent to area businesses for ads or donations in the booklet. Someone is needed to create and coordinate this work. Volunteers are needed for donation collection 1 hr. before the fireworks. Volunteers are needed to find door-to-door donation collectors. In the past, the football boys have collected door-to-door in subdivisions, which has been extremely helpful. Contact the CIA to see if they will run a raffle to raise money for fireworks.

\*\* Additional activities can be planned by other groups or organizations and is encouraged. Coordinators for the sand volleyball and shooting contest and other games/activities.

*Creepy Car Cruise-In* – This event will be held Saturday, October 4<sup>th</sup> in Dooley Park from 3 – 7 pm. There will be no rainout date.

*Downs Haunted House* – This event will be the second of the two large events. Downs Haunted House is a self-funding event through admission costs of the Haunted House.

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Dates: Every Friday and Saturday on October for the Haunted House

Times: 7:00 – 11:00 PM

Admission: \$15+ fees for online ticketing

Additional details: Hayrack ride will be available on each date the Haunted House or UnHaunted House is open.

Park Activities:

- Start/End Hayrack ride
- Food for sale – provided by Downs CIA or other if needed
- Photo Booth and Ticket Sales/Questions

Oct 26<sup>th</sup> 1:00 – 3:00 Un-Haunted Lights on – Free activities for kids, turn on all lights, pass out candy/small toys for each child, hayrack rides.

*Christmas in Downs* – This celebration event starts after Thanksgiving and continues through the end of the year. The Events Committee will ONLY be doing the following for this event:

- 1) Put up banners and flags down Seminary and Washington Streets. Once downtown sidewalks and lighting are remodeled, we will plan for additional lighting in this area.
- 2) Decorate the downtown area with their events provided light displays.
- 3) Hold three sessions for “Cookies with Santa”. The sessions will be 9 am-12 pm and 4-7 pm on Saturday Dec 6<sup>th</sup> and Dec 7<sup>th</sup> from 1-4 pm. It will include refreshments; professional photo and your son/daughter or family will get a photo and letter from Santa. Donations are accepted. Tickets are required only for the “child”. Parents and Grandparents do not need to get a ticket.
- 4) A sub-committee will need to coordinate the design, installation, and removal of the lights in Dooley Park. The sub-committee will provide more details about decorating the park. The Events Committee will provide some funding each year to help support purchase of new decorations for the park.

*Easter Breakfast and Egg Hunt* – This event will be hosted in Dooley Park on the Saturday, March 28, 2026. Easter is on April 5, 2026). The event will involve the area Churches. Also, we will hold a fund-raising breakfast to help with funding this event. Breakfast will start at 7 am and continue until 10 am. Registration for the egg hunt will be from 10-10:30 am with the activities starting at 10. Focus should be on a family breakfast prior to the activities, and it will be a donation breakfast and location will be announced in February.
