 - 4. Don't think they will have food from Scouts, but asked that they make that choice

 - 6. Movie needs to change at the request of the sponsor
 - 7. They would like us to show Incredibles 2
 - 8. Question: if it rains do, we still want to hold in the Pavilion?
 - 9. Julie is requesting a quote for the new movie
 - 10. Question: Snacks? Do we still want to do snacks of popcorn and cotton candy?

 - 2. Hand sanitizer will be given to patrons when they enter the rules area
