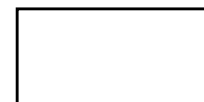


Clue 6

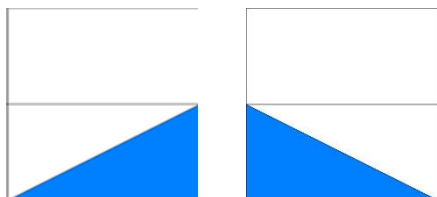
Assembly



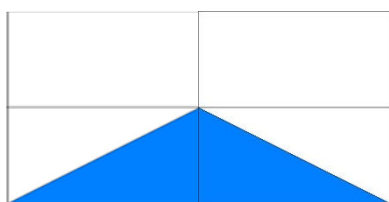
Amber		
Rectangles	Cut Size	Quantity
White	2 1/2" x 4 1/2"	12

A Few Border Units

1. Cut 12 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles.
2. Line right sides of the 4 1/2" edges with the white edge of the left dog tooth split units. Sew 1/4" seam.
3. Press seam open.
4. Repeat with the right dog tooth split units.



5. Line up left and right dog split units with white rectangles with the short blue sides together.
 6. Sew 1/4" seam.
 7. Press seam open.
- Make 6 units 4" x 8" finished,
4 1/2" x 8 1/2" unfinished.



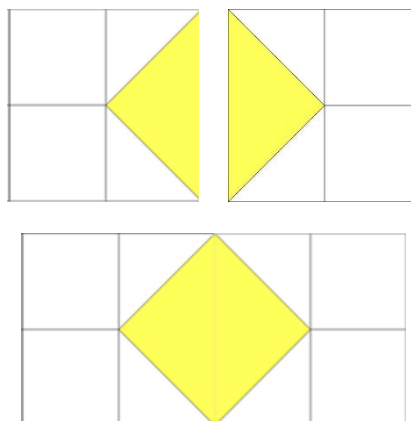
Block Sub-assembly

1. Line up the remaining left and right dog split units with the short blue sides together.
 2. Sew 1/4" seam.
 3. Press seam open.
- Make 42 units 2" x 8" finished,
2 1/2" x 8 1/2" unfinished.



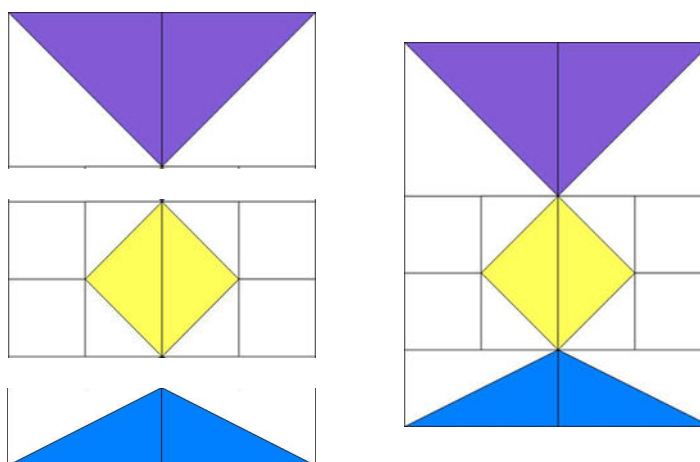
Flying Geese Units

1. Line up yellow edges of flying geese units with right sides together. (As pictured below.)
2. Sew 1/4" seam.
3. Press seam open.



Block Assembly

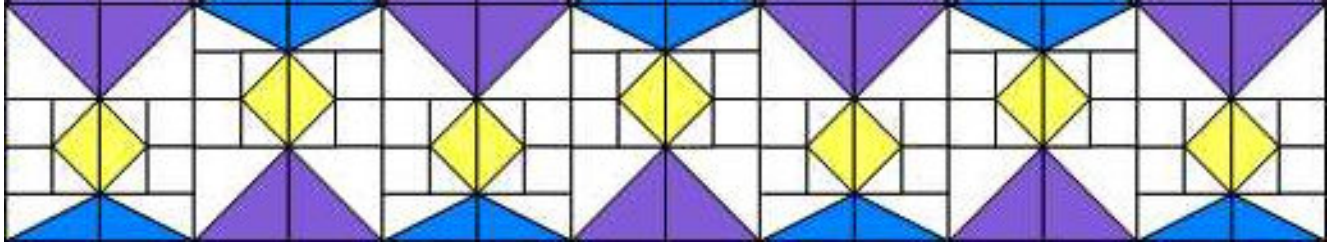
1. Line up units with right sides together. (As pictured below.)
2. Sew 1/4" seam.
3. Press seam open.



Make 42 blocks 8" x 10" finished,
8 1/2" x 10 1/2" unfinished.

Quilt Row Assembly

1. Line 7 blocks up alternating purple up and down. As shown below.
 2. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam.
 3. Press seams open.
 4. Repeat to make 6 rows.
- 56" x 10" finished, 56 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.



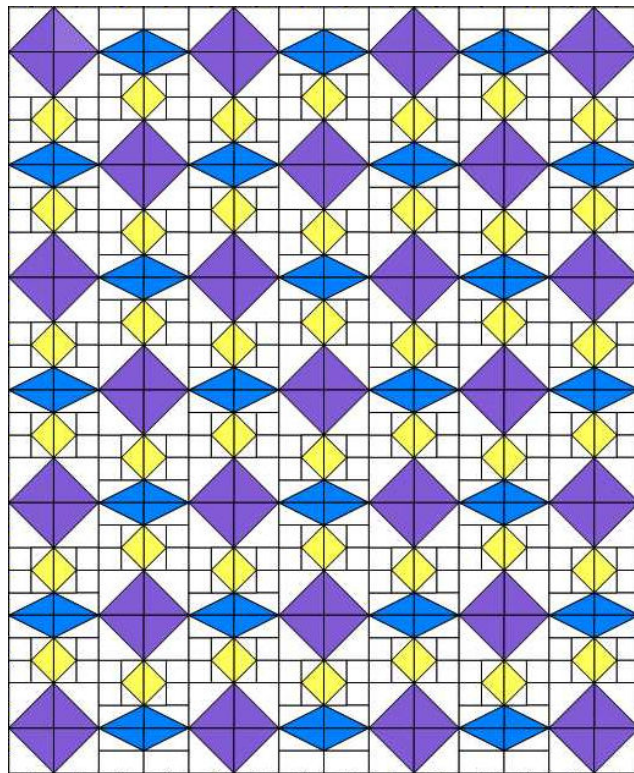
Top and Bottom Rows

1. Line up remaining purple and white half square triangle units and the dog tooth split units, as pictured below.
 2. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam.
 3. Press seams open.
 4. Make two rows.
- 56" x 4" finished, 56 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.



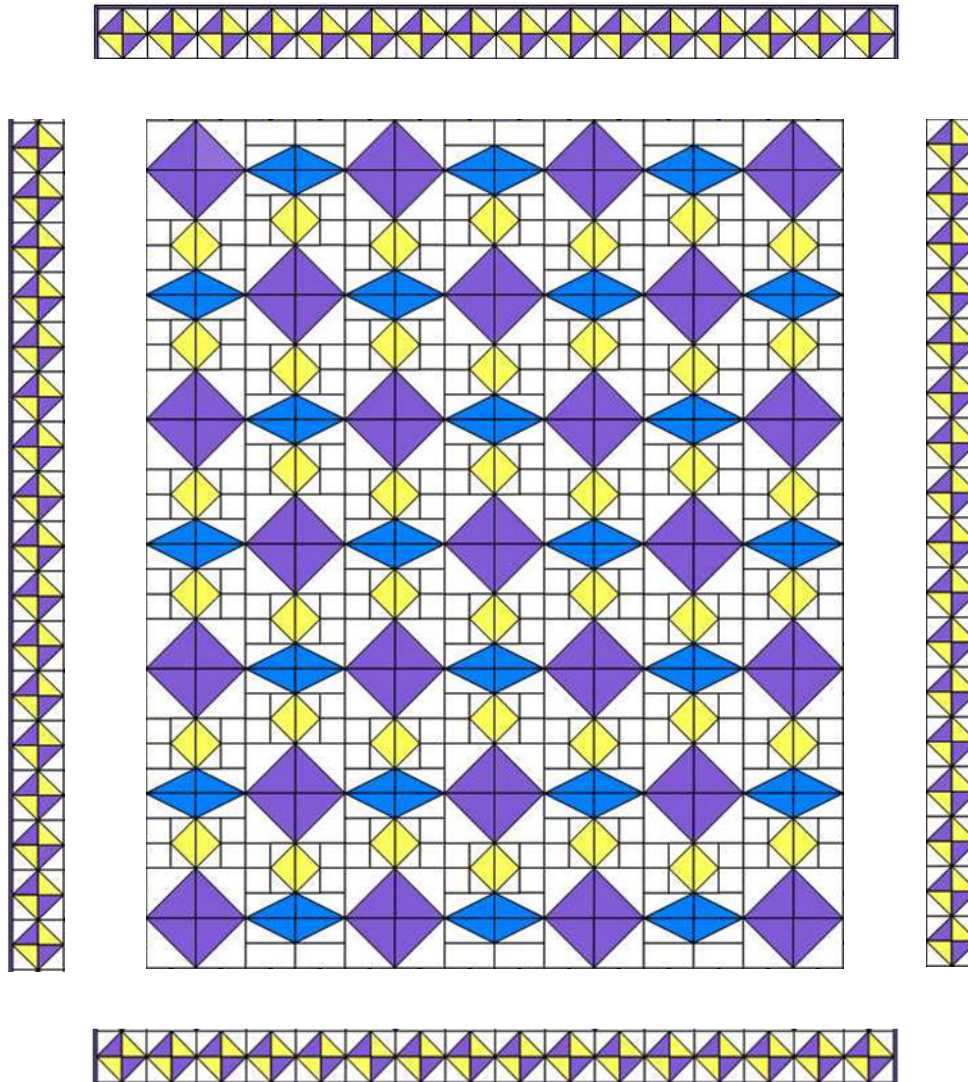
Quilt Body Assembly

1. Line rows up as pictured.
2. Sew rows together.
3. Press seams open.



Outer Border

1. Arrange purple, yellow and white square in a square units from clue 2 as shown below with 17 units in the side borders and 16 units in the top and bottom borders.
2. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams.
3. Press seams open.
4. Sew side borders to quilt body.
5. Sew top and bottom borders to quilt body.
6. Press seams open.



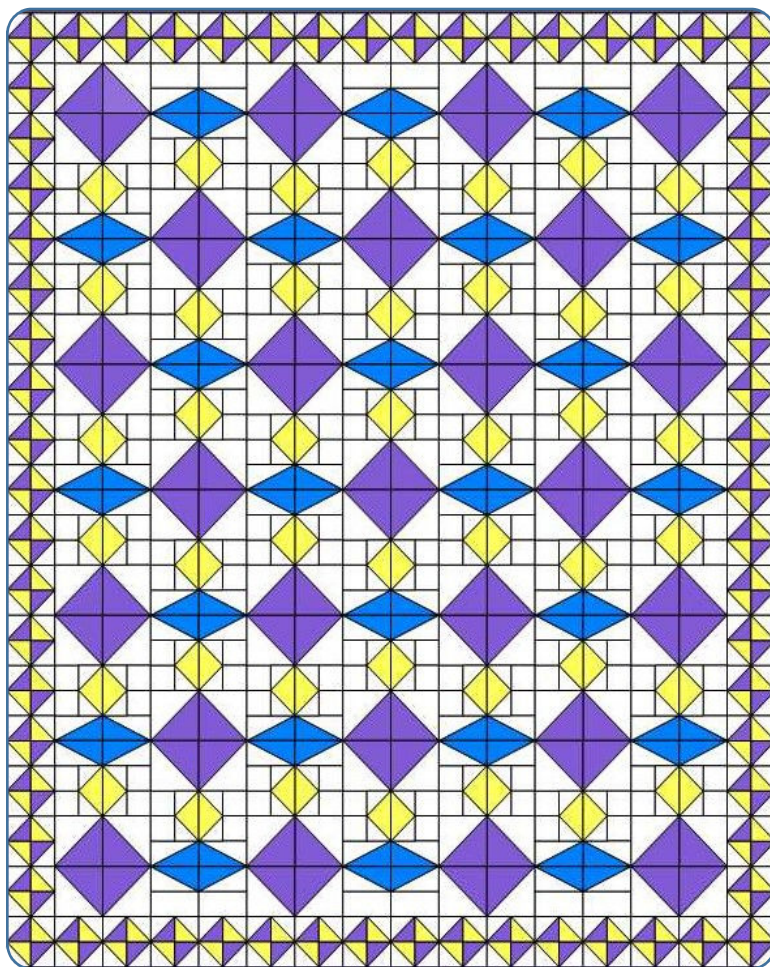
Finishing the Quilt

Layer and quilt as desired.

Amber		
Backing 108" wide		2 1/2 yards
Binding 42" wide		1/2 yard

Corner Curves

1. Trim quilt.
2. Round the corners with the Curved Corner Ruler by Creative Grids, using the 3" radius.
3. Bind with bias binding.
4. Label.



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
