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2-16-1 Administrative Hearing Officer

(A) Appointment

The Administrative Hearing Officer shall be appointed for a term of two (2) years by the Board of Trustees. Additional Administrative Hearing Officers, as may be needed to transact the appeals, may be appointed by the Board of Trustees for a term of two (2) years.

(B) Oath

Before entering upon the duties of his office, an Administrative Hearing Officer shall take an oath or affirmation that he will support the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of the State of Colorado and the laws of the Town of Grand Lake and will faithfully perform the duties of his office.

(C) Monetary Compensation

The compensation of the Administrative Hearing Officer is set by the Board as listed in Grand Lake Municipal Code 2-14-2.

(D) Duties

The duties of an Administrative Hearing Officer are listed in Grand Lake Municipal Code 1-1-11.



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
