

**TOWN OF GRAND LAKE
ORDINANCE NO. 01 - 2018**

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CERTAIN PARTS OF THE TOWN OF GRAND LAKE
MUNICIPAL CODE 11-4-7 [BOARDWALKS, SIDEWALKS, AND COMMUNITY
GREENWAYS] BOARDWALKS TO BE MANDATORY IN CERTAIN PARTS OF TOWN, AND
MUNICIPAL CODE 11-4-9 (B) [BOARDWALKS, SIDEWALKS, AND COMMUNITY
GREENWAYS] COMMUNITY GREENWAYS**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Grand Lake (“the Board”), Colorado, pursuant to Colorado State Statute and the Grand Lake Town Code, including but not limited to section 2-3-2, is vested with the authority of administering the affairs of the Town of Grand Lake, CO; and,

WHEREAS, the authority of the Board includes, but is not limited to, adopting ordinances and resolutions, including those that amend, repeal, or in any way affect the Code; and,

WHEREAS, The Board previously adopted Ordinance 14-1985, an ordinance creating material and construction standards for boardwalks and sidewalks, providing for the inspection of existing and new boardwalks and sidewalks, and providing for the enforcement thereof; and,

WHEREAS, The Board previously adopted Ordinance 01-2009, an ordinance amending the Town of Grand Lake Municipal Code Chapter 11, Article 1, Boardwalks and Sidewalks by adding Community Greenways; and,

WHEREAS, The Board previously adopted Ordinance 10-2016, and ordinance amending the Town of Grand Lake Municipal Code Chapter 11, Article 4, Section 7 Boardwalks, Sidewalks, and Community Greenways – Boardwalks to be Mandatory in Certain Parts of Town by adding 11-4-7(C) Boardwalk Fee-in-Lieu; and,

WHEREAS, The Planning Commission unanimously supported Town Staff recommendation to repeal Municipal Code section 11-4-7 and 11-4-9(B) at the January 3rd, 2018 Planning Commission meeting; and,

WHEREAS, The Board has discussed this matter at the February 12th, 2018 workshop session and has determined that Municipal Code sections 11-4-7 and 11-4-9(B) no longer hold application with the Town

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
TOWN OF GRAND LAKE, COLORADO;**

THAT, Sections 11-4-7 and 11-4-9(B) of the Grand Lake Municipal Code are hereby repealed.

Severability: If any Article, Section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Board of Trustees declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each part or parts thereof irrespective of the fact that any one part or parts be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

Repeal: Existing Ordinances or parts of Ordinances covering the same matters as embraced in this Ordinance are hereby repealed and all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, except that this repeal shall not affect or prevent the prosecution or punishment of any person for any act done or committed in violation of any Ordinance hereby repealed prior to the taking effect of this Ordinance.
