

**TOWN OF GRAND LAKE  
ORDINANCE NO. 03 - 2018**

**AN ORDINANCE DISCONTINUING THE MUNICIPAL FEE ESTABLISHED  
BY ORDINANCE NO. 06-2017**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Grand Lake Board of Trustees, pursuant to Colorado Statutes and the Grand Lake Municipal Code, is vested with the authority of administering the affairs of the Town of Grand Lake, Colorado; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to such authority, at its regular meeting on November 27, 2017, the Board adopted Ordinance 06-2017 establishing a quarterly fee for providing street lights, police services, and dispatch services (“the municipal fee”), with such fee to take effect January 1, 2018; and

**WHEREAS**, subsequent to the adoption of Ordinance 06-2017 the Board received several comments from citizens expressing concern with the municipal fee and whether such services should be paid for through a municipal fee or from the Town’s general fund and other revenues; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board has heard and carefully considered the concerns expressed by its citizens related to the municipal fee and, based on those considerations, has determined that the municipal fee should be discontinued, and

**WHEREAS**, the Town has assessed, and is in the process of collecting, the quarterly municipal fees for the first quarter and second quarter of 2018.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF GRAND LAKE, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The quarterly municipal fee established by Ordinance 06-2017 for purposes of providing street lights, polices services, and dispatch services is hereby discontinued effective as of the third quarter of 2018.
2. The discontinuance of the municipal fee beginning with the third quarter of 2018 shall not alter in any manner the validity of the municipal fee assessments for the first and second quarters of 2018 and such fees shall be due, payable, and collectible as provided in Ordinance 06-2017.
3. Further funding for street lights, police services, and dispatch services shall be paid from the Town’s general fund and from such other sources as the Town may obtain.
4. Severability: If any Article, Section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Board of Trustees declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each part or parts thereof irrespective of the fact that any one part or parts be declared unconstitutional or invalid.


5. Repeal: Existing Ordinances or parts of Ordinances covering the same matters as embraced in this Ordinance are hereby repealed and all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, except that this repeal shall not affect or prevent the enforcement of obligations of any person for any act done or omitted in violation of any Ordinance hereby repealed prior to the taking effect of this Ordinance.
