

My favorite time of the year for fiber arts! Once the holiday hub bub is over, there is nothing more satisfying than letting your creative juices flow! Fleeces To Pieces has lots of yarns and ideas for you to get 2023 off to a good start.



The Naughty or Nice Challenge was lots of fun. Everyone was very nice! We had 37 participants, and 9 beat the challenge to win a \$20 gift certificate! We have 2 large bins of donations heading to Wilmington's LifeCare and Foster Pantry, Inc. organizations as a result.

The 2022 Sock Challenge was also a huge success. Of the 15 participants, 2 completed the 12 pair challenge (\$20 in gift certificates), 2 completed the 6 pair challenge (\$10 in gift certificates), some learned new techniques, and everyone enjoyed sock yarn discounts! Anticipate something different in 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter for the 2023 Challenge!

At this time there are no plans that impact business hours of the shop.

#### WHAT'S NEW AT THE SHOP?

During the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter most of the purchases were replenishing existing stock. Three new yarns were introduced:

- Laines du Nord-Cashsilk Light 131 yards of Sport/DK 70% Merino, 10% Cashmere, and 20% Silk in 3 colors
- Malabrigo-Caprino
   164 yards of DK 80% Merino, 20% Cashmere in 6 colors
- Interlacements-Baby Rick Rack 900 yards of Sport 100% Rayon in their new Sunflower colorway

#### TEXTILE / FIBER GUILD

#### **EVENTS**

Fleeces To Pieces will be scheduling some classes and Knit Along activities on Wednesday evenings this quarter in addition to the classes we offer during business hours. This quarter we will have:

- Spinning wheel spinning class offered by Nina Zonnevylle,
- Rigid heddle weaving class offered by Nina Zonnevylle,
- 3-D felted fox Make & Take Party offered by Brenda Pazar,
- Continuous Strand Washcloth offered by Audrey Kruse,
- Big blanket finger knit class offered by Jo Caracappa. Get the details below!

**Knit Alongs** Audrey Kruse will initiate 3 Knit Alongs in January. They are all different, so read the details carefully. Try one or try them all! Email <u>fleecestopieces@gmail.com</u> if you would like to join in the fun!

**Stars Falling Double Knit Cowl KAL.** This is a pattern by Juniper Moon featuring two colors of Herriot Great yarn. The pattern is available at the shop for \$1.00. I am ordering the 2 colors featured in the pattern, and have a few other colors available to choose from. I am making my shop model in a worsted weight yarn by adding 1 iteration of the 12 stitch repeat into the pattern. This creates several other yarn options for purchase, or you can use your own yarn.

If you would like help in reading the pattern, learning the double knit cast on and double knit stitch, there is a workshop for this scheduled on Wednesday, January 11<sup>th</sup> from 6:00 to 8:00 pm. (You must register by eod Saturday, 1/7) The workshop is \$35 per person. If you can't make the class, but need help getting started, you can schedule a 1 hour knitting one-on-one with me to get you started for \$20. You are welcome to work on your own, or join us at Sit & Knit on Thursday or Saturday afternoons to work with others! This one completes at your own pace, and will be great to work between sections of the other 2 KALs scheduled this quarter.

**Felted Beach Bag KAL.** This KAL has no official start date, but we will be scheduling a felting day for KAL participants in March. The price of the felting day will be \$30. More details to come.

The kit sells for \$80 and includes 6 skeins of Cascade 220 yarn, the downloadable pattern which includes felting instructions, a lingerie bag, a button and a project bag. Pre-orders can be taken now, and the kits will be available January 16<sup>th</sup>. If you are only interested in the yarn and pattern, they can be purchased separately if you would like to start now!

Knitted Argyle Teddybear KAL. Cuteness abounds with this adorable knitted stuffed bear. The pattern that will be used is from the book 60 Quick Knitted Toys featuring Cascade 220 Superwash yarns. I will be creating a-la-carte bundles that will be sold at 10% off if you sign up for the KAL. The bundles include any of the following:

• Cascade 220 Superwash full ball main color \$11.50 (or 4 full balls)



- Three 25 oz partial balls for the Argyle and facial features \$9.00
- Bobbins \$10.00
- Stuffing (quantity and price will be determined once I finish my model!)
- Apron \$8.00
- Pattern Book \$18
- Pattern sections that coordinate with the 3 workshops \$1 each
