



# Field of Flowers Quilt

By Ashley Hough | Finished Size: Approximately 56" x 56" | Block Size: 10" Finished

### Fabric Requirements

*Based on 40" to 42" of usable fabric.*

**Fabric 1** (Light Teal)- ¼ yard

**Fabric 2** (Medium Teal)- ¼ yard

**Fabric 3** (Light Orange)- 3/8 yard

**Fabric 4** (Medium Orange)- 3/8 yard

**Fabric 5** (Light Yellow)- ½ yard

**Fabric 6** (Medium Yellow)- ½ yard

**Fabric 7** (Light Grey)- 3/8 yard

**Fabric 8** (Medium Grey)- ¼ yard

**Fabric 9** (Green)- 5/8 yard

**Fabric 10** (Cream)- 2 ½ yard

### Cutting Instructions

From **Fabric 1**, cut;

-(**3**) 2 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut into (**40**) 2 ½" squares

From **Fabric 2**, cut;

-(**2**) 2 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut into (**20**) 2 ½" squares

-(**1**) 2" x WOF strip, sub-cut into (**20**) 2" squares

-(**1**) 1 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut into (**20**) 1 ½" squares

From **Fabric 3**, cut;

-(**4**) 2 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut into (**64**) 2 ½" squares

From **Fabric 4**, cut;

-(**2**) 2 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut into (**32**) 2 ½" squares

-(**2**) 2" x WOF strips, sub-cut into (**32**) 2" squares

-(**2**) 1 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (**32**) 1 ½" squares

From **Fabric 5**, cut;

-(**6**) 2 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut into (**96**) 2 ½" squares

From **Fabric 6**, cut;

-(**3**) 2 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut into (**48**) 2 ½" squares

-(**3**) 2" x WOF strips, sub-cut into (**48**) 2" squares

-(**2**) 1 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut into (**48**) 1 ½" squares

From **Fabric 7**, cut;

-(**8**) 1 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut into (**200**) 1 ½" squares

From **Fabric 8**, cut;

-(**2**) 2 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut into (**25**) 2 ½" squares

-(**1**) 1 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut into (**20**) 1 ½" squares

From **Fabric 9** cut;

-(**5**) 2" x WOF strips, sub-cut into (**100**) 2" squares

-(**8**) 1 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut into (**200**) 1 ½" squares

From **Fabric 10**, cut;

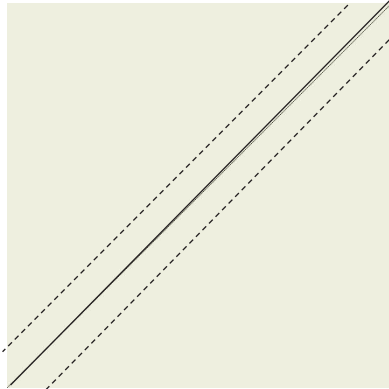
-(**10**) 2" x WOF strips, sub-cut into (**200**) 2" squares

-(**41**) 1 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut into (**40**) 1 ½" x 10 ½" strips, (**300**) 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles and (**300**) 1 ½" squares

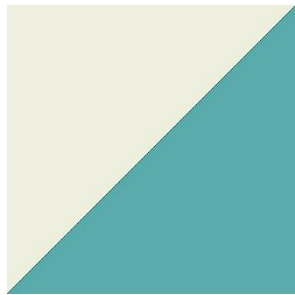
-(**6**) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips short ends together to make one long strip. From the long strip, cut (**4**) 1 ½" x 54 ½" strips.

### Unit Assembly

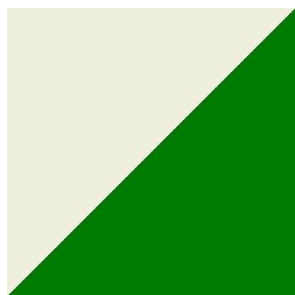
1. On the wrong side of a 2" **Fabric 10** square, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Place the marked square right sides together with a 2" **Fabric 2** square and sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on both sides of the drawn line.



2. Cut apart along the drawn line and press towards **Fabric 2** to make (2) Half Square Triangles. Square to  $1\frac{1}{2}$ ". Repeat to make (8) total **Fabric 10/Fabric 2** HSTs.



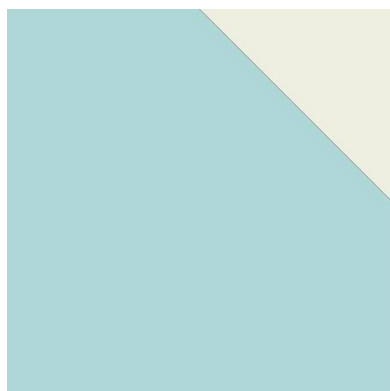
3. Repeat the previous steps to make (8) total HSTs using 2" **Fabric 10** and **Fabric 9** squares.



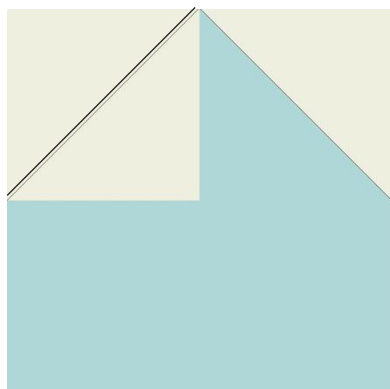
4. On the wrong side of **(2)** 1 ½" **Fabric 10** squares, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Place one of the marked squares right sides together with a 2 ½" **Fabric 1** square as shown.



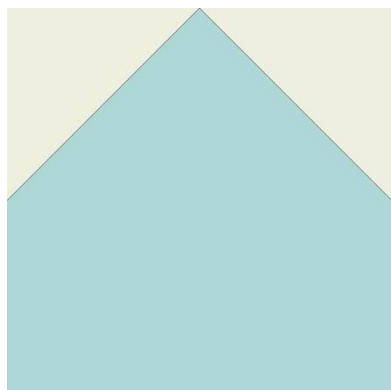
5. Stitch on the drawn line, then trim seam allowance to ¼" and press towards **Fabric 10**.



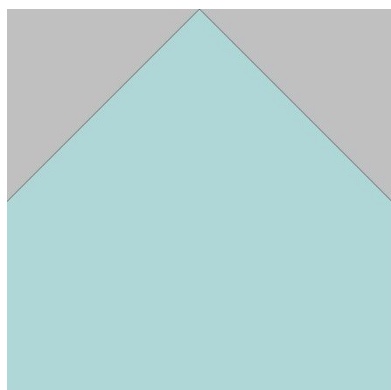
6. Place the remaining marked square right sides together with the unit from the previous step as shown.



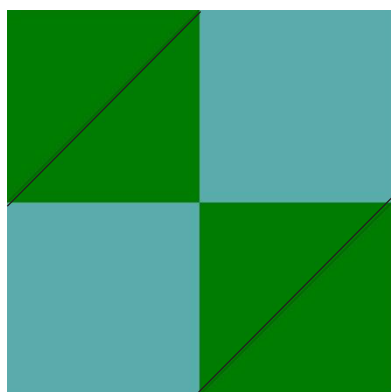
7. Stitch on the drawn line, then trim seam allowance to  $\frac{1}{4}$ " and press towards **Fabric 10**. Repeat to make **(4)** total matching units.



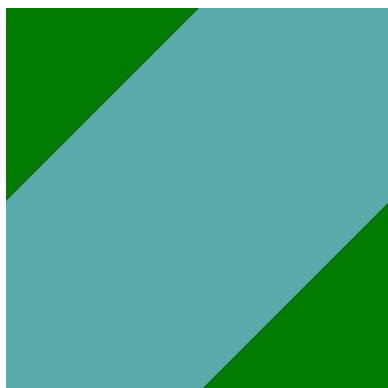
8. Repeat the previous steps to make **(4)** total matching units using  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric 7** and  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric 1** squares.



9. On the wrong side of **(2)**  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric 9** squares, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Place the marked squares right sides together with a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric 2** square as shown.

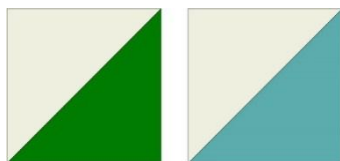


**10.** Stitch on the drawn lines, then trim seam allowances to  $\frac{1}{4}$ " and press towards **Fabric 9**. Repeat to make **(4)** total matching units.

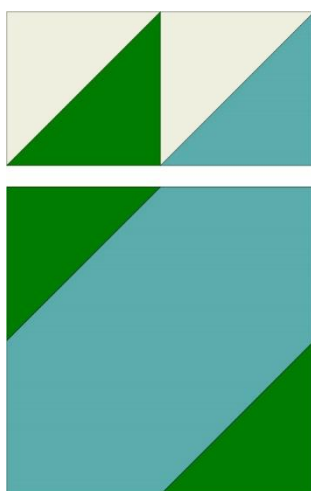


**Block Assembly**

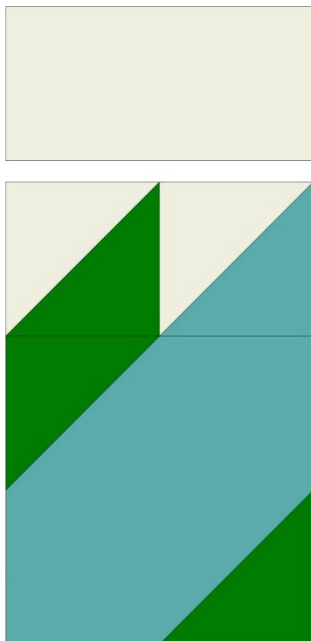
**1.** Lay out a **Fabric 10/Fabric 9** and a **Fabric 10/Fabric 2** HST as shown and sew together.



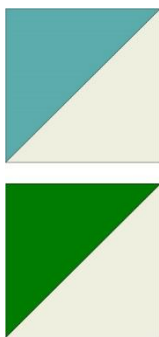
**2.** Lay out the following unit and the HSTs from the previous step as shown and sew together.



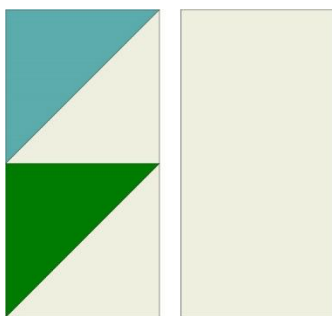
3. Sew a 1 ½" x 2 ½" **Fabric 10** rectangle to the top of the unit from the previous step as shown.



4. Lay out a **Fabric 10/Fabric 2** and a **Fabric 10/Fabric 9** HST as shown and sew together.



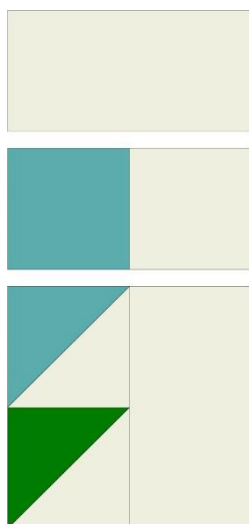
5. Sew a 1 ½" x 2 ½" **Fabric 10** rectangle to the side of the unit from the previous step as shown.



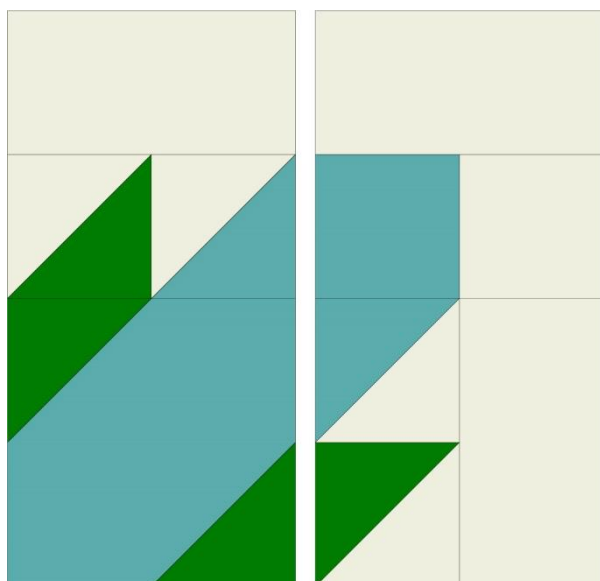
6. Lay out a 1 ½" **Fabric 2** and **Fabric 10** square as shown and sew together.



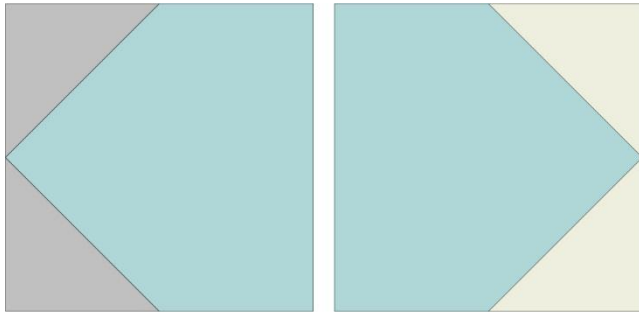
7. Sew a 1 ½" x 2 ½" **Fabric 10** rectangle to the top of the pair from the previous step and a unit from step 5 to the bottom as shown.



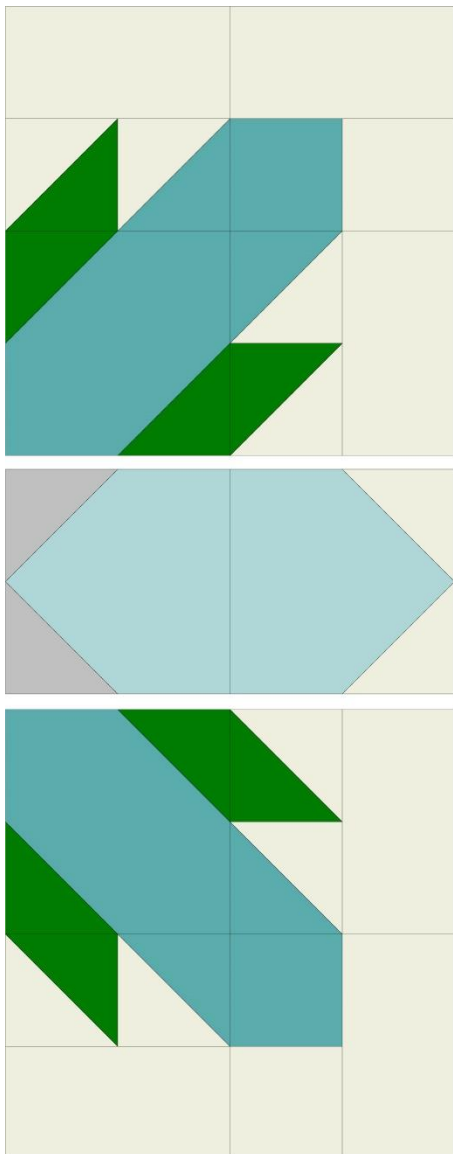
8. Sew the unit from the previous step and a unit from step 3 together as shown. Repeat to make **(4)** total matching units.



9. Lay out the following units as shown and sew together. Repeat to make **(4)** total matching units.



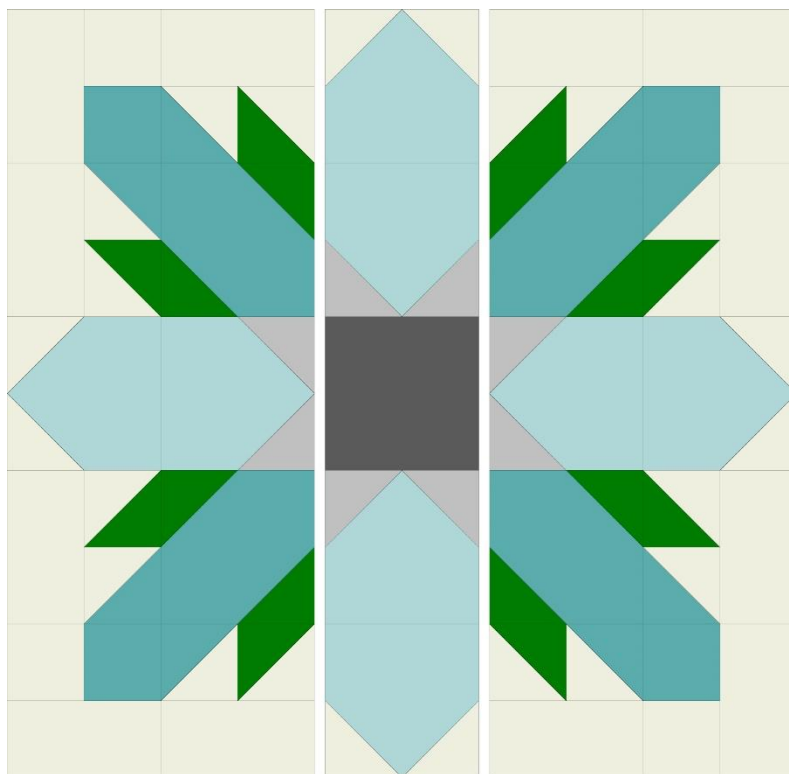
10. Lay out one unit from step 9 and two units from step 8 as shown and sew together. Repeat to make a matching row.



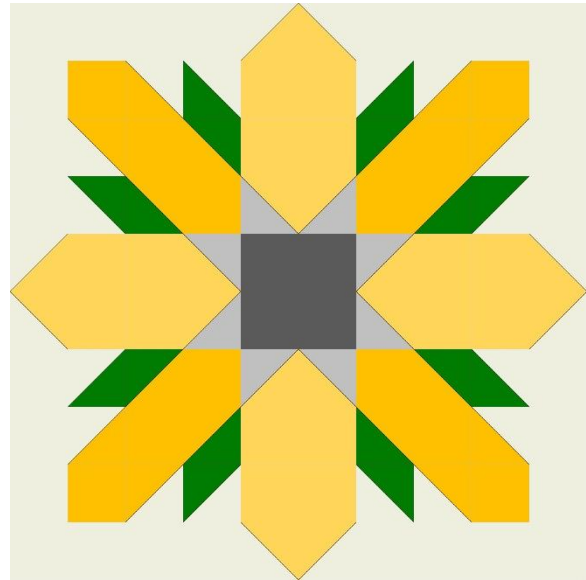
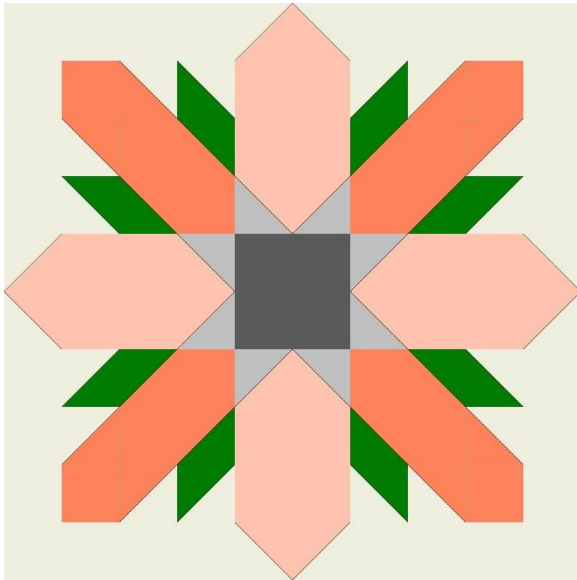
11. Lay out two units from step 9 and a 2 ½" **Fabric 8** square as shown and sew together.



12. Lay out the three rows as shown and sew together to make a block. Block should measure 10 ½" square. Repeat to make **(5)** total blocks in this color combination.

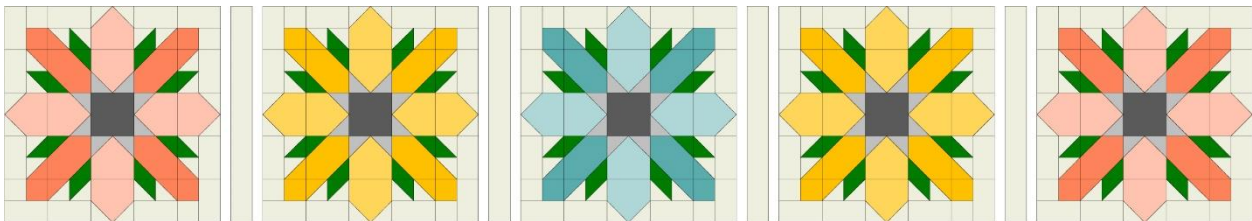


13. Repeat the previous steps to make **(8)** total blocks using **Fabric 3** and **4**, and **(12)** total blocks using **Fabric 5** and **6**.

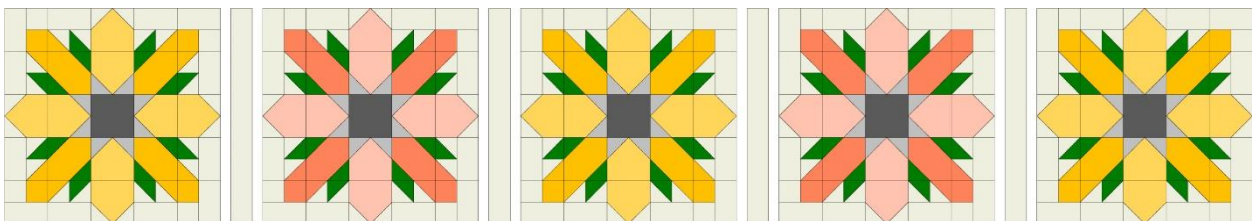


### Quilt Assembly Instructions

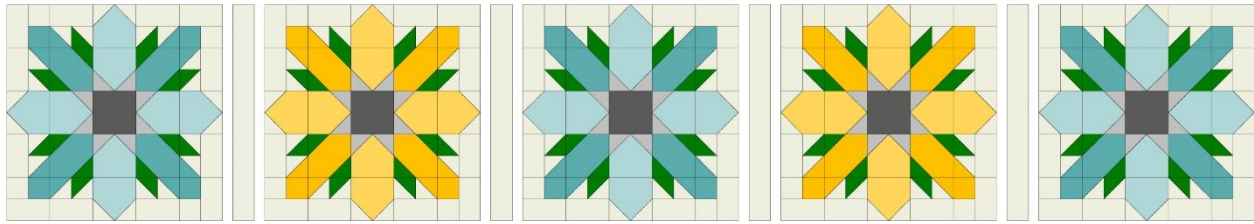
1. Lay out the following blocks and **(4)** 1 ½" x 10 ½" **Fabric 10** strips as shown and sew together into a row. Repeat to make a matching row.



2. Lay out the following blocks and **(4)** 1 ½" x 10 ½" **Fabric 10** strips as shown and sew together into a row. Repeat to make a matching row.



3. Lay out the following blocks and **(4)** 1 ½" x 10 ½" **Fabric 10** strips as shown and sew together into a row.



4. Lay out **(5)** 1 ½" x 10 ½" **Fabric 10** strips and **(4)** 1 ½" **Fabric 8** squares as shown and sew together. Repeat to make **(4)** total matching rows.



5. Sew a 1 ½" **Fabric 8** square to both ends of a 1 ½" x 54 ½" **Fabric 10** border strip. Repeat to make a matching strip with corner squares.



6. Using the following **Assembly Diagram** for reference, lay out the rows as shown and sew together. Sew a 1 ½" x 54 ½" **Fabric 10** border strip to both sides of the quilt, then sew the border strips with the corner squares to the top and bottom.

7. Layer with batting and backing fabric and quilt as desired.
