

# Bag Ladies Class

## Class Description:

Pick and purchases any by Annie pattern to make for this class

## Depending on which project you choose, you will learn some new skills:

- Expand your zipper-installing skills and possible learn to use Zippers by the Yard
- Discover how to make vinyl pockets
- Mesh pockets will be easy-peasy
- Learn the secrets to sewn-in hook and loop fasteners
- Learn Annie's method for machine sewn bindings
- Make versatile handles and straps
- Rounding corners
- Attaching invisible magnetic snaps

## Class Supply List:

- Your chosen by Annie project pattern
- Fabric and supplies as listed on the pattern back cover
- Thread to match your fabrics

## Also Bring to Class:

- Sewing machine in good working order with a walking foot, 1/4" foot, and zipper foot. If you have a Teflon foot for your machine, bring it too, to facilitate stitching on the vinyl. Don't forget the extension table for your machine.
- Rotary cutter and rulers
- Chaco-liners or other marking tools
- Tube turner
- Bodkin
- Basic sewing kit including #90/14 topstitch needles, Wonder Clips, a stiletto/pressing tool, pins, scissors, thread, washable glue stick, basting tape, etc. (If something in this list is unfamiliar, don't worry, we will share in class and the store stocks all of them.)

## Before Class:

To make the best use of class time, please cut out the fabrics and quilt according to the instructions in the pattern BEFORE coming to class. Sub-cut the quilted units as directed in the pattern. All pieces should be labeled. Most of the by Annie patterns have a page of labels that you can copy, cut apart, and pin to your pieces. Sew 1/8<sup>th</sup> inch around every quilted piece.
