## Supplies:

- Fabric for circle quilt
  - Center of quilt:
    - 1 charm pack for blocks (36 squares total)  
or fussy cut (36) 5" squares
    - 1 $\frac{1}{4}$  yard background fabric
  - Narrow border & binding:  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard
  - Outer border:
    - 1 charm pack for piano key border  
or fussy cut (38) 5" squares  
or cut (76) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5" pieces  
OR 5/8 yard fabric
- Thread to match background fabric
- Freezer paper
- Washable glue stick (I like the Sewline Glue pen)
- Basting glue (I like Roxanne's or Jillily's)

## Tools:

- Sharp, pointy fabric scissors
- Paper scissors
- Pencil - regular graphite (mechanical pencil is preferred)
- Rotary cutting supplies including a 6" wide ruler
- Optional: C-Thru ruler to draw lines
- Optional: Compass to draw circles

Please make sure that your machine is in good working order.
