Show Regulations

Declination of Entries:

The Wichita Dog Training Club, Inc. may decline entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of aggression, disease, deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No one shall have any claim or recourse against the Wichita Dog Training Club, Inc or any official thereof.

Bitches in season are not permitted in the trial.

The club will refund all but \$5.00 per RUN for the following days of the entry for bitches that are unable to compete for that reason.

Dogs injured and not able to compete:

They will be refunded all but \$5.00 per RUN for the following days of the entry with a note from your veterinarian stating that they should not compete.

The Trial Secretary must be notified of such a claim for refund by letter or email by the end of trial.

Entry fees will not be refunded:

In the event the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee or other acts beyond the control of the Trial Committee it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Exhibitors must be governed by any rules or regulations or civil authorities, building and parking restrictions.

Vehicles parked contrary to regulations will be subject to towing at the owner's expense.

Notice To Exhibitors

The safety of the dog(s) is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors are acknowledging that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dog(s) are familiar with and able to perform the obstacles safely. This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older and **open to all breeds** that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registrable breeds that have obtained AKC ILP /PAL or Canine Partners numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. All dogs must be always on leash except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such a case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

“Anyone in violation of a restriction pursuant to AKC rules or policies, or the law can be asked to leave the grounds. If the person fails to leave, the local authorities will be contacted. In addition, if the club believes laws, restrictions, or conditions of release are being violated by an individual's attendance or participation in AKC events, the local authorities will be contacted immediately as they have the authority of enforcement.”

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

The Trial Secretary will add a \$35.00 service charge for any returned checks.

Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries.

We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT FEES.

Canadian exhibitors must submit entries with international money orders guaranteed in U.S. Funds.

NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED WHICH REQUIRE A SIGNATURE FOR DELIVERY.

Entries not on official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Changes, Additions, or Corrections to entry forms MUST be received in writing or by email prior to closing of entries. Those received by telephone are NOT acceptable. **Errors on entry blanks:** Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms whoever may have made such errors, and no entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellations of entries after the published closing date. Each entry form must be signed.

Awards

A qualifying score is required for all awards. Placement ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th place in each height division of each class at each trial. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score.

New title ribbons will be awarded where appropriate. A commemorative MACH/PACH ribbon and bar will be awarded to each dog earning a MACH/PACH title at these trials.

Photography

No flash photography will be allowed while a dog is running on the course.

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers with Weaves be either, both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day. Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day. *A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.* When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

Trial Information

- All crates must be on crate mats.
- No Food allowed on the turf, there will be designated “treat” areas outside of the rings to reward your dogs at.
- Please potty dogs at the designated areas and pick up after your dog. There will be a \$5 fee for any accidents on the turf.
- Exhibitors seen not picking up after their dog(s) may be asked to leave the trial.
- FEO (For Exhibition Only) will be offered at this trial. Announce it at the gate before you enter the ring.
 - Leashes can be worn or put in pockets.

Standard and Preferred Class Heights

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the running of the course.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is allowed in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered at any level (Novice, Open Excellent or Masters) in FAST, JWW, Standard or Premier classes. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.
- Course time for FEO in Time 2 Beat, JWW, Standard, Premier and ISC will be 45 seconds. FAST course times for each class/height are as noted in the Regulations.

Move-Ups

Dogs may be moved to a higher class at the request of the owner, because of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary **no later than 3 days prior to the first day of the trial.**

Move-ups after Thursday of the trial must be made within 15 min. of the end of the last class. Dogs so moved up will be entered at the end of the running order. A move-up form is included in this premium.

Entry move-up valid only if the dog was already entered at the event and only if approved by the Trial Secretary.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners ProgramSM may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
