Other Sewing Supplies Required GO! dies (see page 2) You may bring your GO! cutter, or use the stores.
 Portable iron with ironing mat for work station.
 Fabric treatment: Acorn Fabric Treatment, Best Press Fabric Treatment or alternative.

Basic Rotary Cutting Supplies - (Rotary cutter, mats, rulers, extra blades, etc.)

Other Cutting Supplies Fabric scissors. 45° rotary cutter with new blade. Cutting mat for your workstation.
 Ruler: recommend 6 1/2" x 24 1/2" or similar.

Other Supplies Needed

Pre-Class Preparation

A simple by versatile block, this block lends itself to many designs and uses. We will be working with fussy cutting fabrics and directional fabrics. Easier to fuzzy cut than you think.

Required to make sample block:

Fabric: one fat quarter each of four colors, one with pattern that can be fussy cut, one directional, a light and a dark, varied by print, pattern, color, shade, value. Good contrast is important.

PROJECT: Table runner, with variety of layouts. Fun Project.

Fabric: 1 1/2 yd each of four colors. That are color coordinated and "play well together"

One fabric with a design that can be fuzzy cut to the size of your Cube's #1 Shape.

One fabric that is directional: stripes are a good choice.

One light fabric.

One dark fabric.

Neutral thread: white, gray or tan

Qube: You can use any size cube. You will need dies 1,2,4 and 5. Easiest is to just bring the entire cube.

We will also play with variations of the block that add interest.

Please download the Free Qube booklet for your sized CUBE from the Accuquilt website Go to accuquilt.com. to download.

Search for "Cube Booklet", choose your size Qube and download. Save entire booklet to your computer. (no need to print the entire booklet.

Click on "Add to Downloads"
Click on "Download Library" in the upper right corner of the page to access the booklet. Once Downloaded you can print out the pages you will need for each block.. Blocks are in alphabetical order.
find: sawtooth Star (page 93 & 94) Block, print the two pages of instructions for this block.
