Other Supplies Needed

Pre-Class Preparation

All supplies are available at 35th Sew and Vac.

- 1.) Any teeny tiny Laura Heine pattern. It should be around 16" x 20"
- 2.) Pattern ease 3/4 yard. This is used as a foundation
- 3.) Fabric scraps for your collage. Look at the pattern and call the instructor upon signing up. 406-314-3235
- 4.) Steam a Seam 2 ONLY(No Substitutes) Enough to iron on all material you will be using. Look at the pattern. Start with 3 yards of 12" or if it is wider you can use less yardage. DO NOT iron ahead of time.
- 5.) Karen Buckly serrated blue handle scissors. No substitutes unless approved by the instructor.
- 6.) Fuse Mat 17 x 24" or bigger. This is not an applique sheet
- 7.) OPTIONAL: Sew tites (magnetics to keep your pattern ease and pattern together. You can use pins as well.
