Other Supplies Needed

Pre-Class Preparation

Requirement for taking this class you need to have taken Beginning Ruler Work Class on Domestic Machines.

Ruler work foot for your machine.

Rulers you will need:

Westalee Sampler Template Set 6 piece, make sure you have the correct shank set for your machine.

Westalee 8 point Crosshair Template - this is a marking tool.

Fabric:

Outside fabric - this is the side that we will quilt on and will show on outside of roll - 1/3 yard  
Batting and backing fabric- 1/3 yard (backing fabric will not show at all)

Fabric to sew pockets onto - 1/3 yard - this will show only between your pockets

Inside fabric - for pockets - 1/3 yard of 2 contrasting fabrics (I used a print and a solid, the solid looks like a binding on edge of pocket)

Binding - 1/4 yd

Thread for quilting and piecing

6" X 24" ruler for marking or any size their about and a rotary cutter.

Marking pen or pencil that will show on your fabric.

Safety pins for quilt sandwich, quilting gloves if you use them. Table for sewing machine is a must, unless the bed of the machine is wide enough to place the quilting rulers on without the ruler tilting.

Ruler Roll Pattern

Button or ribbon for closure on roll, you can make it out of fabric also.

Handi Grip for your rulers.

Bring all supplies to class. DO NOT CUT FABRIC.
