Basic Sewing Kit - (scissors, pins, thread, hand sewing needles, seam ripper, etc.)

Other Sewing Supplies Specialty feet you can use Ruffling Foot, Lace application, Standard Foot and Beading foot. Beads must fit in the tray on the Beading Foot. Sizes 4mm or 6mm check your size specification. Spools of serger thread that match your fabrics. Decorative threads 8-wt (smaller number larger the thread). For rolled hem or rolled edge - 2 spools Poly-Yarn, 1 serger thread (for best results all the same color) Wave stitch 1 spool serger thread and 2 contrasting colors.

Basic Rotary Cutting Supplies - (Rotary cutter, mats, rulers, extra blades, etc.)

Other Supplies Needed

Pre-Class Preparation

WOF = Width of Fabric

Holiday Serger Trees

Styrofoam trees are available in the floral dept at some stores that carry crafting supplies.

Large 17", Med 12" or 9", small 6"  
other sizes may be available

T-Pins

Fabric Trees (amounts are for 1 tree)

Small tree 1/4 yd +

Med tree 1/3 yd +

Large trees 1/2 yd +

Gift Wraps and Ribbons

1/2 to 2 yards (Single fabric layers)  
Sheers can be 2 layers.

Ribbons or laces, see pre-requisite column for quantities.

I will bring some lace, ribbons, beads, floral wire and fishing line.

Holiday Serger Trees

Starch fabric 2 times (not the sheers)

Sub cut (qty is for 1 tree)

Small Tree 1 ea. 2" WOF (40")

Medium Tree 2-3 ea. 2-1/2" WOF (80" to 120")

Large Tree 4-5 ea. 2-1/2" WOF (160" -200")

If using ribbons or lace for the med or large trees we will serge the strips together like a binding, measure to determine how much of the ribbon or lace you'll need.

Ribbons

Sheer fabric for Ribbons single layer

Cut 8-10 2-1/2" Strips WOF

Gift wraps

Medium Size fabric Cut 2 18" circle

We can cut the circles at the at the meeting.  
I will bring my circle making rulers
