Other Supplies Needed

Pre-Class Preparation

Your choice of Fabric, cork, or faux leather per pattern requirements

1/8" Double Sided tape

seam roller - helpful

Thread to match faux leather or cork

#5 zipper per pattern

Hardware kit for the Book or 4 Bag Feet, and 1 Handmade Label hardware. Optional Rivets

Teflon foot is very helpful

E6000 or similar glue

Please have all fabric cut, except faux leather or cork, and batting applied per pattern directions. The cork or faux leather will be cut in class.
