## ALL SUPPLIES ARE AVAILABLE AT 35TH AVENUE SEW & VAC

For class you will need the Westalee Sampler Template Set 1, make sure you purchase the correct shank height for your machine. This comes with 6 different rulers and we will work with them all. Please do not wait till class to buy the rulers.

You will need a ruler foot for your sewing machine. Most machine brands make a ruler foot for their machine or you can buy Westalee's ruler foot. Bernina makes a ruler work foot just for Bernina machines, please make sure you have that on your Bernina machine. 35th Ave Sew and Vac has ruler feet for Bernina, Babylock and Brother, Pfaff Husqvarna, Viking and Juki. You will need to know if your machine has a low or high shank. If you do not know what shank your machine uses ask 35th Ave. Please do not wait till class to buy the ruler foot.

Bring any Rulers for quilting with you that you have already purchased, make sure they are the correct shank size for your machine.

4 quilt sandwiches at least 18" X 18", use material of your choice. You may bring more quilt sandwiches. Quilt sandwiches do not need to be basted.

Thread for quilting – please use something that you will be able to see on your fabric. Please make sure it is good quality thread.

Marking pen or pencil that will show on your fabric.

Quilting gloves if you use them.

**DO NOT WAIT TILL DAY OF CLASS TO PURCHASE YOUR FOOT AND RULER SET.**
