Other Supplies Needed

1 package - 8 7/8" 12 Petal Dresden Plate
(Makes 2 plates)
Fabrics - 12 assorted fabrics 3" x 5" for the petals and 1 more fabric 4" x 4" for the center circle = 13 fabrics in all. You can use scraps or a charm pack if you like.
Glue pen - Sewline or similar
Glue pen refills
Silicone mat
Threads:
 50 wt. thread for basting shapes
 60 wt. or 80 wt. matching for sewing shapes together
Needles:
 John James Cotton Darners for basting
 John James Milliners for whipstitching
Sandpaper board
Fiskars 1/16" hole punch
Clover applique pins
Clover Wonder Clips or Mini Wonder Clips
Mechanical pencil
Pen
Mechanical chalk pencil - Bohin or Sewline
Container to hold supplies

FOR LATER:

If you are making a clock, you will need:

1 OESD clock kit or similar kit
1/2" yard of SF101 interfacing
E6000 adhesive

If you are making a quilt block, you will need:

A 15" square piece of fabric for the background.
Thread to applique the dresden plate onto the fabric square, either by hand or machine.
