Pattern - Vessels by Jean Paccagnan of SoTreasured.com
Fabric - 1/2 yard or more cotton quilting fabric - more if you are fussy cutting the fabric.
Stabilizer - Peltex 70 - 1 yard-See NOTE on Peltex 70 on the bottom of this sheet
Glue pen - Sewline or similar
Glue pen refills - Sewline or similar
Thread - 60wt/80wt like Bottom Line or Decobob-needs to match fabrics
Needles - Milliner needles, any size
Black Sharpie - Ultra Fine tip
Wonder Clips
Sandpaper board
Mechanical chalk pencil
Pencil
