Pre-Class Preparation

1/8" Double Sided tape

seam roller - helpful

Thread to match faux leather or cork

#5 zipper per pattern

Hardware kit for the Book or 3-1" swivel hooks, 3-1" D-rings and 1-1" slider buckle

Teflon foot is very helpful

E6000 or similar glue

Please have all fabric cut and batting applied per pattern directions except faux leather or cork. This will be cut in class.
