Other Supplies Needed

You will need three contrasting fabrics of your choice:

Fabric:

Light in color: Center square (1) - 4" x 4" square
(8) - 5.5" x 3.5" Flying Geese Center

Medium in color: (8) - 4" x 4" Flying Geese
(2) - 6.5" x 6.5"

1/2 Triangles

Dark in color: (2) - 6.5" x 6.5" 1/2 Triangles
(2) - 3.5" x 3.5" center block

If you would like to make the pillow you will need a backing fabrics 20" x 20" .

accent Fabric for border.

if making pillow a 14" or Larger zipper

Stablizer needed no show mesh/ or fusible no show mesh.

Fusible fleece or just batting

if making the pillow 14" or larger pillow form.

This project can either be a table topper or pillow it is the students choice.

Bring an assortment of embroidery threads for quilting and wording.

Hoop sizes will very smallest hoop would be a 5 x 7 so please bring all hoops for your machine.
