6 "REPEATS" OF FABRIC AT LEAST 24 INCHES BY WOF. 6 X 24" IS 144 INCHES OF FABRIC, OR 4 YARDS. IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT YOU PURCHASE AT LEAST ONE YARD EXTRA - JUST IN CASE - AND TO INCLUDE A SECTION OF THIS FABRIC IN THE QUILT (FRONT OR BACK) TO SHOW HOW THE FABRIC LOOKED BEFORE IT WAS CUT UP. IF YOU ARE USING A PANEL, YOU WILL NEED SEVEN PANELS. SIX FOR THE HEXAGONS AND ONE FOR THE TOP OF THE QUILT. OUR GREAT STAFF IN THE FABRIC DEPARTMENT CAN HELP YOU WITH YOUR FABRIC SELECTION. REFER TO THE FABRIC SELECTION NOTES IN YOUR BOOK, ONE BLOCK WONDER.

Please cut 6 repeats of your fabric. If you have any questions, please ask at the cutting table.  
If you are using a panel for this project, simply have all six panels separately cut.  
PRESS YOUR REPEATS WELL USING A NON STARCH ALTERNATIVE ACORN FABRIC TREATMENT® OR BEST PRESS®.  
The better your fabric is prepared the more enjoyable the work, and the better the end product.
