WOF = Width of Fabric

Confident or Advance serger

- 1 - yd for the Base
- 1 - 1/4 - yd for the Waist Band
- 5 - 1/4 yd for the Ruffles (5 different colors)

Beginner

- 1/2 yd for Body and Pocket
- 1/2 yd for Accent Cuff and waist band

Bib either apron

- 1/ 2 yd for Bib Body
- 1/4 yd for Sashing
- 1/4 yd for Neck Strap

WOF = Width of Fabric

Confident or Advance serger  
Med or larger sized apron

Body Fabric

Measure your waist and divide by two that  
number will be the aprons body  
width \_\_\_\_?\_\_x 20" long

- 5 - Ruffle fabrics cut to 5 1/2" by WOF
- 2 - Waist Band 5" X WOF

Beginner

Med or larger sized apron  
Measure your waist and divide by two that  
number will be the aprons body  
width 14" x ?" Wide or your measurement  
(the pattern calls out 14"x30")

Body Fabric Cut

- 1 - Rectangle 14" x 30" Wide  
(or your measurement \_\_\_\_)
- 1 - Rectangle 8" x 16" \_\_\_\_

Accent Fabric cut

- 1 - Rectangle 9" x 30" Wide  
(or your measurement \_\_\_\_)
- 2 Strips 4" x WOF
