☒ Other Supplies Needed

- * Your Pattern;
- * Fabric-pre shrink & dry in your dryer - according to your pattern & your size;
- * Eye glasses if you need them;
- * Note paper for taking notes;
- * Recommend Quilters Select 60 wt. 2 ply or Isacord 40 wt.:
- * Pellon #906F Ultra Lightweight Fusible Interfacing (per your pattern requirements;
- * Pellon 815 red dot tracing fabric.
- * ---35th Avenue Sew and Vac sells a wide variety of these supplies for those of us who always forget something.
- * Be ready to shop after class for your next project!

☒ Pre-Class Preparation

- * Do Not Buy/Trace Your Ready to Wear Size Pattern! If you need help, Call Teresa.
- * Trace your size on the red dot tracing fabric (according to bust measurement, OR for pants according to your hip measurement) - in a complete front pattern
- * and - a complete back pattern, but DO NOT cut the pattern at the edges, leave room to make adjustments to this sizing, both in the upper portion of the pattern and the body-bust line and below.
- * After altering the pattern pieces, you will be cut on a single layer of fabric, so you need a complete front, etc.
- * DO NOT trace the sleeve pattern (if you are making a top or dress), we will do that in class.
- * Wear undergarments that you will wear with your completed garment.
