Other Supplies Needed

Pre-Class Preparation

1. 1/2 yard of PFD (prepared for dyeing) fabric or more! You can never have enough!
2. Batting
3. Freezer paper to create your design from your photo
4. Sharpie
5. Pencil
6. Light Box
7. A small set of Inktense Blocks or you can also buy the Inktense Paint Pan Travel Set
8. Inktense Pencils – 12 or 24 Set
9. Paint Brushes - You should already have brushes from Beginning Inktense, but feel free to bring what you want. I use 3 chisel brushes from Simply Simmons: 3/8" , 1/2", and 1/4". You can get them on Amazon or Blick Art
10. Spray Bottle
11. Bottle to squirt water into an artist palette dish
12. Artist Palette Dish
13. Paper Towels
14. Craft exacto knife or other small knife to shave the sticks with
15. Small Pencil Sharpener
16. Textile Medium – you used it in Beginning Inktense. My favorite is Ceramacoat Delta Creative Textile Medium. Its hard to find but Amazon may have it. My backup is Josonja Textile Medium. You can get that on Amazon as well.
17. Sturdy cup to hold water – I use glass because it 's heavy and I won 't spill it.
18. Small 2 oz cup to hold your medium. Next time you are at a fast-food place grab one with the lid! I will bring some just in case!
19. Hair Dryer

## PRIOR TO CLASS:

Please enlarge your photo the size you would want. I suggest something no bigger than 18x24. You can enlarge either in black or white or color, whichever will give you the best color values that you can see!
