Other Supplies Needed

Pre-Class Preparation

All paints, brushes, stencils and other supplies will be provided for you

1. 1 -2 yards PFD (Prepared for Dying) white fabric. Most students just love what they create. I suggest cutting your fabric into fat quarter size, unless you have something in mind that you will want to use in a project.
2. Hair Dryer
3. Latex Gloves
4. Paper Towels
5. Squirt bottle for water
