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☒ Other Supplies Needed

Enough background fabric to create a pillow sham for your desired size pillow. (5/8 yard is enough for a 16"x16" pillow).

Thread for sewing the pillowcase.

Embroidery thread according to thread chart. Substitutions can be made, as long as you have enough colors for all of the thread changes in the design.

6"x6" squares of scrap fabrics for appliqué pieces, according to which design you choose:
Floral 1 - two pieces for flowers
Floral 2 - one piece for pumpkin
Floral 3 - three pieces for individual letters
Floral 4 - none

(Optional) Portable iron & ironing mat as we will be using a fusible appliqué paper.

☒ Pre-Class Preparation

Pre-wash & iron pillow sham fabric according to how you plan on washing your finished project.

Students will have enough time in class to do approximately two of the designs. Prepare templates according to which designs you would like to do.

Print or trace appliqué templates onto the OESD's Appliqué Fuse & Fix for the design(s) of your choice. Be sure to mirror the templates when doing so.
