Snack Time Pattern has 5 sizes Baby-King

I'm listing the 3 small sizes if you need/want the larger sizes check the pattern or let me know.

Baby Size, finished size 37" x 48"

18 Assorted 2-1/2 strips

1-1/4 yd Contrasting Fabric

1/2 yd Binding

2-1/2 yd Backing

Batting (pre-packaged baby size)

Lap Size, finished size 51" x 72"

36 Assorted 2-1/2 strips

2-1/2 yds Contrasting Fabric

5/8 yd Binding

3-1/4 yd Backing

Batting (pre-packaged twin size)

Twin Size, finished size 65" x 88"

56 Assorted 2-1/2 strips

3-5/8 yd Contrasting Fabric

3/4 yd Binding

5-3/8 yd Backing

Batting (pre-packaged full size)

The pattern shows the colors in the block are made from 2 shades of the same color. With a white solid in the middle (hex).

To make this more interesting you can change the middle hex to whatever you want or even make the whole thing scrappy (except contrasting color).

Hexes are made from strips 4-1/2" by WOF
Strips required Baby 4, Lap 8, Twin 12.

You can reduce the Contrasting Fabric qty approx. by: Baby 18", Lap 36", Twin 54".

You can make this very scrappy by using a different color for each hex.

All or most of items are available at the 35th Ave Sew & Vac locations.

☒ Pre-Class Preparation

If you have the pattern or templates before the first date you can follow the instructions on sub cutting the strips into the Half Hex, Hex's and Triangles see pattern for sizes and amount

Fabric preparation: Do Not Wash

Press and starch strips and contrasting fabrics

Most pieces will be sub-cut at angles so handle with care.
