

Embroider and Assemble OESD Tile Scenes 101

This is a two session project based class where you will learn the basics of creating a tile scene. Project will be one of the two new OESD Tile Scenes “Tiled Stockings



The first session (Sat 7-11) will focus on hooping the fabric and recommended stabilizers. Due to high stitch count and time required to stitch each tile, 1-2 tiles will be stitched in class. The remaining tiles are to be stitched at home prior to the 2nd class (Sat 7-25), where the focus will be final assembly of the tiles and stocking.

Class Supplies:

Class 1:

- The OESD Tiled Stocking Packet installed on your machine
- Embroidery Machine with at least a 7x7 hoop (if you usually use a basting stitch, you will need a hoop that is at least a 10x10)

- Fabric
 1. 1 ½ yards of navy quilter cotton for Santa stocking or
 2. 1 ½ yards of Cream quilter cotton for Poinsettia stocking
 3. ½ yard of quilters cotton for lining per stocking
 4. 3"x8" scrap for hanging loop
- Stabilizers
 - Heavy Duty Tear Away
 - Ultra Clean and Tear
 - Fusible Woven – Pellon SF101
- Thread based on the recommendations shown in the design packet for the stocking you plan on doing
- Extra bobbin with black thread for the seam
