Other Supplies Needed

Pre-Class Preparation

Must have items for class:

Kit for Fabric-available at the cutting counter, this fabric kit must be purchased to make the block in class.

Thread-Basting threads-any thread 50 wt.-this thread will be removed after piecing-it does not have to match fabrics.

Piecing brands are:

Bottom Line 60 wt. or Decobob #80 wt are recommended. This thread needs to match coordinate with fabrics.

Paper Pieces Honeycomb 1" 100 ct.

Paper Pieces Square 1" 150 ct.

Mini Wonder Clips or similar

John James Milliner needles Size 10-10 ct.

John James Darner needles Size 9-12 ct.

Clover Applique glass head pins

Magic Mirrors 5" x 5"

Container to store items and fabrics.

Optional items that are helpful:

Sandpaper board, Bohin or Sewline chalk pencil with thin white lead, 1/16" Fiskars hole punch, Clover needle dome (for storing needles in), personal light, personal magnifier to see work up close, needle threader, pincushion for pins.
