Pre-Class Preparation

Items Needed:

Pattern - Vicki will give you the pattern in class.

Yankee Pride block papers by Paper Pieces-available in the Rulers section near the Notions

Fabric - White for all of the diamonds-1/4 yard;
Red for the squares in the center-1/8 yard;
Blue for the rest of the shapes-1/4 yard
Threads - For basting- any 50 wt. thread, any color is fine since it will be removed once the block is completed

For stitching-60wt/80wt like Bottom Line or Decobob-needs to match fabrics

Needles - Milliner needles, any size

Mechanical chalk pencil with white lead

Chalk pencil refills with white lead

Pencil

Wonder Clips

Fiskars 1/16" paper punch

Clover Applique pins

Sandpaper board

Small plastic zipper bags to help organize the many pieces for this block.

Sharpie marker to mark each zipper bag.
