Stabilizer - Batting or sew in interfacing - 6" square - used to stiffen the hexie flower

Threads - 50 wt. thread for basting hexies
60 wt. or 80 wt. matching for sewing

hexies together

Needles - John James Cotton Darners

John James Milliners

Fiskars 1/16" hole punch

Sew-in Magnet set of two - HARMAGNTWO

Clover applique pins

Sandpaper board

Clover Wonder Clips

Mechanical pencil

Pen

Crushed walnut shells- about 3-4 cups
