Class supply list for Stitcher's Garden 1

Class #1: We will go over all the items needed. **Please bring those items starred to first class.**

Note the first class is extended.

- *Sewing Machine, in good working order
- *Owner's Manual for machines other than Bernina
- *Bring all feet and accessories you have to the first class (no embroidery modules)
- *Machine needles: For piecing and applique. (We will also use double needles; wing needles; topstitch needles but not for the first class)
- *Machine feet: $\frac{1}{4}$ " foot, open-toe foot
- Quilters Seam guide (for the machine—usually part of the accessories)
- Batting: Quilter's Dream (poly or cotton) Request, Double, for making the blocks
- Fusible web: (Steam a Seam Lite II)
- *Thread for piecing
- Thread for quilting the background (Aurifil 2021 recommended)
- *Scissors, Paper and Pencil
- Spray Starch (recommend Mary Ellen's)
- Spray Adhesive (optional)
- 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square ruler (recommended)
- Teflon applique pressing sheet
- Air soluble marker or fine point disappearing ink pen
- Template Plastic

Each month bring extra material for practicing quilting and applique. Fat quarters and scraps are OK.

******For the first class bring a 16-18" square of muslin with batting fused for practicing.***

Each month a variety of threads will be used for the decorative stitching.
