Acrylic Paints: A basic set of primary colors plus any additional desired colors is a good start. Amsterdam Acrylics offer a wide range of colors and are quite affordable. This course is more about the emotional process of painting than color mixing, so get colors you are drawn to.

Brushes: Short handle
One small round,
One medium filbert and
One large/wide (1inch or larger) soft flat or hake brush
One Fan brush

Princeton Select Sets are good for additional variety beyond above listed.

Palette: This can be as simple as a paper plate or small round plastic palette, paper palettes are a good option as well.

Plastic palette knife for mixing colors

Water container: any empty jar or plastic tub will work.

Paper towels or rags/cut up old t-shirts

Sketchbook and Pencil

Marbles 10 or more

Ball Chain (like you see hanging from a ceiling fan or key chain) at least 12 inches long.

Plastic Fork
