CHRISTMAS WITH SUE! BLOCK OF THE MONTH: BLOCK 11

Fabric Requirements:

1-14" Tan (Background)

1-5" Square Red Floral Print

(Dress, 2 Sleeves, Hatband)

1-3" \times 5 $^{1}/_{2}$ " Green with Red Print

(Collar, 2 Ruffles, Pocket, Coat Tail)

1-3" x 5" Brown Print (Window Frame)

1- $3^{1}/_{2}$ " x $4^{1}/_{2}$ " Red Stripe

(Bonnet, Pocket Top, 3 Pom Poms)

1- 3" \times 4 $^{1}/_{2}$ " Floral Print (Stained Glass)

1- 21/2" Square Black (Shoe, Book)

1-2" Square Green (Holly)

1-2" Square Flesh (2 Hands)

11 Green Beads

3 Small Red Beads

Cutting Instructions:

14" Square Tan

Sewing Instructions:

Find the center of the 14" background block. Follow the instructions on page 1 to create applique pieces and fuse to the background.

Remove the portion of the window frame so when layered the "Glass" shows through the holes.

The applique pattern shows dashed lined for the pieces to be removed. The placement pattern has dashed lines to show placement of the glass underneath the window frame.

Once fused, stitch a blanket or other desired decorative stitch around the appliques.

Sew a bean stitch to give the book definition (shown as blue line on placement pattern).

Sew seven green beads on the back of the dress. Sew a green bead on the pocket and one on each of the pom poms. Sew three red beads on the holly. (Shown as green dots on placement pattern).

Trim block to $12^{1}/_{2}$ ". Ready for next block!

How to Apply Fusible

Our Laser Cut Kits Have Soft Fuse.
Remove paper from the back of each applique piece to expose fusible web. Use a hot dry iron for 8-10 seconds to fuse into place.
Keep fabric side up and glue side down when fusing!
