Improve your embroidery skills and learn new techniques while trying a variety of machine embroidery products.

Receive a Kimberbell project bag and fabric kit with all the Kimberbellishments, plus step-by-step instructions and project CD.

### Supplies Needed

- Embroidery machine\* in good working order with electrical cord & Instruction manual. Basic Knowledge of Machine Operation-- *\*All participants must know how to operate their embroidery machine.*
- Embroidery hoops for your machine (5x7) and (6x10) hoops
- Embroidery Arm (if separate from machine)
- Embroidery Thread to compliment projects- teal, red, pink, green, gray, tan, white, black\*
- Prewound bobbins with White and Red bobbin thread
- Embroidery Needles 75/11 and 80/12
- Embroidery scissors, rotary cutter and ruler
- Chenille Cutter and Chenille Brush (optional -Available at Bear's Paw)
- Water Soluble pen, needle for hand sewing (this project can be finished by hand sewing at home)
- Seam Ripper
- Stabilizer— See project sheet.

We used Isacord Teal #4620, Red#1902, Pink#2520, Green#5610, Gray#0142, Tan#0761, Black#0020, and White#0010
