Receive a Kimberbell project bag and fabric kit with all the Kimberbellishments, plus step-by-step instructions and project CD.

**Supplies Needed** Embroidery machine\* in good working order with electrical cord & Instruction manual. Basic Knowledge of Machine Operation-- *\*All participants must know how to operate their embroidery machine.*

- Embroidery hoops for your machine (5x7) and (6x10)
- Embroidery Arm (if separate from machine)
- Sewing machine
- Embroidery Thread to compliment projects- **We used Isacord**, and specific colors will be advised. See Sewin' With My Gnomies project sheet with your kit for thread colors.
- Prewound bobbins with **White, Red** bobbin thread
- Embroidery Needles 75/11 and 80/12
- Embroidery scissors, rotary cutter and ruler
- Pinking shears (optional)
- Fray Check
- Water Soluble Pen
- Seam Ripper
- USB to transfer designs from cd provided in kit to embroidery machine
- Stabilizers—1. Cut away like no show mesh
  2. Tear away and sticky back wash away
  3. Cut away like no show mesh
  4. Wash-away and sticky back wash away
  5. Tear away and fusible woven interfacing
