

## Mini Poppins Bag

We will be making the larger size of the Mini Poppins Bag.

If you would like to make your bag with 2 colors and an accent on the bottom and pocket top, you have different fabric requirements.

Bottom and pocket trim:  $\frac{1}{3}$  yard

Body outside and pockets:  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard

Lining, handles, bows, zipper tabs  $\frac{5}{8}$  yard

Please read through the pattern to become acquainted with the pattern and terms. The pattern calls for Bosal Foam for the handles. I find this too thick. We will use fusible 987 for the handles and zipper tabs. If you do not have any I will bring some for you to use. For the body of the bag you will definitely need the double sided fusible foam. Batting or fusible fleece will not give the bag the firmness you need.

Bring all basic sewing supplies, machine in good working order, a frexion pen, or chaco liner for marking quilting lines. A walking foot will be very helpful. Binder clips are helpful when attaching the bottom to the body of the bag, smaller clips work well for other steps of the construction. Don't forget your rotary cutter and rulers.

If you feel comfortable cutting before class, this will save time. Follow all cutting instructions on your pattern. Having your pieces of foam cut prior to class will also help.

There is a refrigerator and microwave available when it comes time for lunch break.
