Pattern: Evening Candlelight Pattern by Tina Dillard, Quilting Affection Designs

Quilt Size: Choose from a Lap, Twin or Queen size.

Fabrics: See the back of the Evening Candlelight pattern for fabric requirements or purchase a kit from Amy's Quilt Room

Studio 180 Design Tools

- Wedge Star or Pint Size (recommend) Wedge Star
- Tucker Trimmer Tool III
- First Choice Ruler 7" x 13" or a Standard 6" x 12" ruler

Please place a new piece of InvisiGrip on the back of the Wedge Star tool. We will be marking the back of your ruler.



Basic Supplies:

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| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sewing Machine and all machine accessories • ¼" sewing machine foot (refer to your sewing machine for the exact foot you will need) • Rotary cutter with a new sharp blade • Cutting Mat • Invisigrip (placed on the back of your tool) • Sharpie™ Ultra Fine Point Sharpie is one that you can see for marking the back of your tool. • Straight edge rulers: 6" x 24" and 6" x 12" • Best Press or light starch (Please do not bring anything scented) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clapper and Press Bars • Paper plates (non-coated) • 50-weight thread neutral color • Needle: Mictotex needle • Snips or trimming scissors • Seam ripper • Pins • Quilter's Magic Wand • Frixon pen marking pen or pencil • Rotating Cutting Mat (optional) |
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Precutting: Please refer to the Cutting Instructions in the pattern or below.

- Label all the strips so you can easily find them when we get started.
- If you are not familiar with the sub-cutting of Wedges, Corner Triangles, please see your Wedge Star tool instructions.

Precutting Instructions: WOF – Width of Fabric based on 42"*

Cut (6) strips 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF, sub-cut into (42) 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ " squares. Cut diagonally once to make (84) corner triangles.
		Small Wedges*	Cut (12) strips 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF, sub-cut (240) Small Wedges using the 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " guideline in the Wedge Cutting Section on the Wedge Star® tool.	Cut (18) strips 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF, sub-cut (360) Small Wedges using the 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " guideline in the Wedge Cutting Section on the Wedge Star® tool.	Cut (26) strips 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF, sub-cut (504) Small Wedges using the 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " guideline in the Wedge Cutting Section on the Wedge Star® tool.

Fabric3 (Medium Blue)		Corner Triangles	Cut (3) strips 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF, sub-cut into (20) 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ " squares. Cut diagonally once to make (40) corner triangles.	Cut (4) strips 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF, sub-cut into (30) 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ " squares. Cut diagonally once to make (60) corner triangles.	Cut (6) strips 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF, sub-cut into (42) 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ " squares. Cut diagonally once to make (84) corner triangles.
