In class, we will be working through the construction steps to create the free bonus project included with the tool instructions. You will learn how to build the basic Star 60 units, assemble them into hexagons, and create the large hexagon center. We will also discuss how to square off the edges to create a small quilt or table topper.

Each student can expect to come away with most of the units pieced and have a sound grasp on how to finish the project at home. We will also discuss some of the extended uses of the tool for potential future 60o projects.

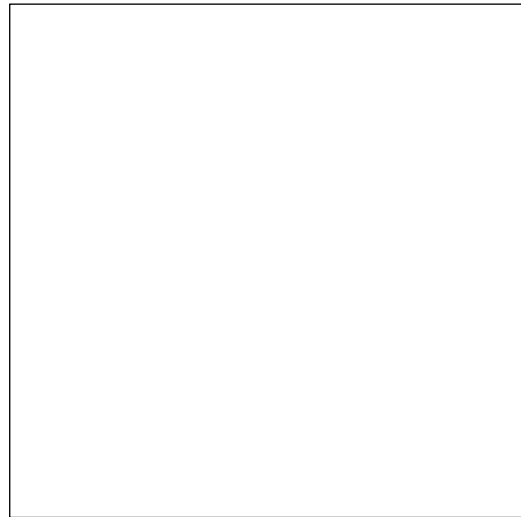
Precutting is required for this class. Please come prepared with your fabrics cut and labeled.

For three color project:

Diamond Background (White)
(4) 3" x WOF Strips

Diamond Unit A (Pink)
(2) 2 ¾" x WOF Strips
(1) 5" x WOF Strips

Diamond Unit B (Green)
(2) 2 ¾" x WOF Strips
(1) 5" x WOF Strips



Hextravaganza Background (Blue) - You will need approximately 1 yard of background fabric for the large setting pieces.

Please Bring Extra Fabrics of Background, Diamond Unit A and B with you to class

- *Studio 180 Star 60 Tool*
- *Bring all extra fabric for all of your fabric choices as a additional cutting my be needed in class.*
- *Studio 180 Star 60® tool*
- *Sewing Machine - in good working*
- *Neutral Colored Thread*
- *Cutting Mat - small to medium size for your work station*
- *Invisigrip™ or Similar Product - for placement on the back of the Star 60. tool*
- *Basic Supplies such as Scissors, Pins, Seam Ripper,etc.*
- *Rotary Cutter - new blade recommended*
