Class Description:

Did you ever want to make a bargello quilt, but were too intimidated? In this class you will learn a simple and easy method for constructing a mini bargello with each block. Together we will complete 4-6 blocks. If you fall in love with the pattern (like I did) you will want to keep going and make more blocks to complete a quilt.

Additional Notes: Students should come to class with the following:

Bring 2 strips (2.5" x 42") of each fabric (Dark, Medium Dark, Medium, Medium Light, & Light) for the class.

If you have taken one of my classes, you have directions on how to find color value.

If you need assistance with choosing your fabrics, please let me know.

Recommended Supply List:

- "Crossing Paths" Pattern by MSQC (available at Southern Charm)
- Rotary Cutter with sharp blade
- Long Ruler (6 ½" x 24")
- Any small ruler with a 2.5" and 5" Mark
- Small scissors or nippers
- Seam Ripper – Necessary for this pattern.
- Pins
- Best Press Fabric Starch
- Sewing machine and power cords
- Mini iron would be helpful, but not necessary.
- Bring your lunch.

Fabric Requirements for Quilt: 63" x 73"

- 1 ¼ Yards Dark Fabric (¾ yard for blocks / ½ yard for inner border)
- ¾ Yard Medium Dark Fabric
- ¾ Yard Medium Fabric
- ¾ Yard Medium Light Fabric
- ¾ Yard Light Fabric
- Outer Border: 1 yard
- Backing: 4 yards
- Binding: ¾ Yard
