



Assembly


- 1. Arrange C squares diagonally as shown in a 4 x 4 grid. If using more than (2) fabrics, aim for even color and print distribution.
- 2. Next, place B triangles around the perimeter of the block as setting triangles so that the longest edges of each triangle will create the outside edges of the block. Place A triangles at the four corners of the block as shown.
- 3. Begin sewing the block together in diagonal rows, alternating the direction in which you press the seams in each row. Sew diagonal rows together to complete block assembly.
- 4. Trim the block to measure 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" ensuring that there is at least a 1/4" seam allowance around all edges. The block is designed to float a bit, so there might be as much as 3/8" 1/2" from the point of the C squares to the edge of the block. Press to complete.
