

Advertisement for Bids
Street Surfacing Improvements
City of Sundance

The City of Sundance, Wyoming is accepting bids to pave and do minor street repair in the City of Sundance.

Bids will be opened and read publicly at the city council room on April 22, 2021 at 3:00 p.m. The City Council will act on the bids at a later date.

The work will consist of laying approximately 950 tons of asphalt paving overlay on existing pavement prior to June 15, 2021. An additional 1780 tons is planned for July 1, 2021 if funds allow.

The project size may be adjusted to meet the funding available. The City of Sundance retains the right to select the bid that is most advantageous to the city and may reject any or all bids without cause.

Bid sheet and location map can be obtained from Sundance City Hall during normal business hours. The sealed bids will be submitted in an envelope plainly marked as "SUNDANCE STREETS BID" to the City of Sundance, P.O. Box 542, Sundance, WY 82729-0542. Any bid received after 3:00 p.m. on April 22, 2021 will be rejected and remain unopened.

BID SHEET

The unit prices times the actual quantities placed for each of the bid items is the total compensation for the street improvement work in the City of Sundance, Wyoming. No bid bond is required, but the successful low bidder will provide the City a performance bond in the amount of the total bid price within ten days of notice of award. Work on Industrial Road must be completed by June 15, 2021. If additional sites are awarded, work shall begin after July 1, 2021.

The construction materials and contract work will be in accordance with the WYDOT Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, Current Edition. The contractor will provide their commercial asphalt mix design (1/2" maximum size aggregate) to the Mayor for his review and approval at least ten days prior to commencing paving operations. No lime is required in this asphalt mix.

The asphalt paving will be paid by the ton "complete in place" including but not limited to street cleaning, tack, traffic control, mobilization, cleanup, overhead and profit.

All paving overlay thickness will be 2" or as noted.

90% payment will be made lump sum following completion of all work. The remaining 10% will be paid when all cleanup is complete, all documents have been submitted, and the Mayor is satisfied with the completed work.

Note #1: All or individual quantities of work may be adjusted by the City to fit the funds allocated for the work.

Note #2: All Thicknesses calculated at 2"

Note #3: #4-A and #7-B is leveling within #4 and #7 respectively

Note #4: All millings will be retained by the City and contractor will place them in an area designated by the City

Note #5: Weight calculated @145 #/CF

The only documents pertaining to this work is the city map provided, advertisement for bids, WYDOT Standard Specifications current edition and this bid sheet. The contractor will be required to obtain a contractor's license from the City of Sundance. The contractor may subcontract portions of the work not to exceed 50% of the total contract amount with the written approval of the Mayor. The Mayor may choose to designate a representative to oversee and coordinate day-to-day construction activities.
