ORDINANCE NO. 1, 1987

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING LIVESTOCK WITHIN THE TOWN; DEFINITIONS; PROHIBITED AREAS; PROTECTION OF EXISTING AREAS; VARIANCE; PENALTIES; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SUNDANCE, CROOK COUNTY, WYOMING:

SECTION 1: THIS ORDINANCE IS ENACTED TO REGULATE LIVESTOCK WITHIN THE TOWN OF SUNDANCE

1-10-301 CONTROL OF LIVESTOCK

Livestock within the Town of Sundance shall be controlled under this chapter and section of the ordinances of the Town of Sundance.

1-10-302 DEFINITIONS

Livestock shall mean animals normally associated with the farming industry and shall include but not be limited to: horses, donkeys, mules, burrows, cows, calves, steers, bulls, sows, boars, pigs, ewes, rams, lambs, llamas, alpaca, goats, chickens, duck, geese, and other poultry.

1-10-303 PROHIBITED AREAS

Livestock will not be allowed within a radius of three hundred feet of more than three residential and/or commercial buildings, excluding the building of the livestock owner.

1-10-304 PROTECTION OF EXISTING LIVESTOCK AREAS

Any areas or property currently within the town limits which legally contain livestock and are not surrounded or located in residential areas, shall be allowed to remain without interference from encroaching residential housing or development.

1-10-305 VARIANCE

Livestock already present within the Town of Sundance upon the enactment date of this ordinance shall be allowed to remain for a period of one year; thereafter those owners shall be required to comply with the terms of this ordinance. In addition, this ordinance shall not be in effect for a period of three days immediately preceding the county fair, during the county fair and for a period of three days immediately following the county fair.

In addition, this ordinance shall not apply at any time to livestock held at the Crook County fairgrounds for 4-H or other fair purposes or to the use of livestock in connection with parades or celebrations.

1-10-306 PENALTIES

Any person found guilty of violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished according to the provisions of Ordinance No. 1, 1983.

SECTION 2: REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH

Any ordinance of the Town of Sundance in conflict herewith be and the same is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY

Should the Courts of this State or the United States declare any section, provision, paragraph, clause, sentence, phrase or part of this ordinance invalid or unconstitutional or in conflict with any other section, provision, paragraph, clause, sentence, phrase or other section, provision, paragraph, clause, sentence, phrase or part thereof of this ordinance, then such decision shall affect only the section, provision, paragraph, clause, sentence, phrase or part thereof declared to be unconstitutional or unauthorized and shall not affect any other part of this ordinance.

SECTION 4: PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall be effective upon completion of all readings and other acts required by law.
