Mayor Brooks signed a Proclamation recognizing January 22-28, 2017 as National School Choice Week. School Choice Week is celebrated across the country by millions of students, parents, educators, schools and organizations to raise awareness of the need for effective educational options.

The Town Council met this day in regular session at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Paul Brooks presiding.

Council Member April Gill was awarded a plaque for 12 years of service as a City Council Member. Ken Denzin was not available to receive his plaque for his 8 years of service as a City Council Member.

Mayor Brooks announced the upcoming meetings – WAM Winter Workshop in Cheyenne-January 11-13, NEWY meeting will also be in Cheyenne at the WAM Workshop on Thursday, January 12th at 6:00 pm. Crook County Solid Waste Joint Powers Board Meeting is scheduled for January 18, 2017 at 6:00 pm.

Jason Vreeland with Trihydro filled in for City Engineer Karla Greaser in her absence. Mr. Vreeland updated the council on the Wyoming Water Development Commission Cole distribution waterline and PRV projects. Surveyors were up and did all the boundary surveying and courthouse research for realignment on the east end of the project. While they were here they also did the surveying for the pump house pump station to help increase the water pressure in the canyon area. Trihydro is hoping to get the DEQ application in for review this month and to WYDOT so they can get the process started. They also worked on easements for the walking path.

COUNCIL MEMBER KLOCKER MOVED, COUNCIL MEMBER MARCHANT SECONDED a motion to allow the Mayor to sign Work Order No: 16-406WO-E-Trihydro to provide professional engineering services to the City of Sundance as the City Engineer. Trihydro will be accessible to the public works director, clerk treasurer, mayor, City Council and other city staff during daily operations. Work to be performed in accordance with the Technical Proposal City of Sundance. Cost of services is \$1700.00 per month All ayes, MOTION CARRIED.

COUNCIL MEMBER KLOCKER MOVED, COUNCIL MEMBER MARCHANT SECONDED a motion to approve Change Order NO. 2-Reduce the budget amount by \$250.00 for a total not to exceed amount of \$148,168.00 per the city crew doing the potholing. All ayes, MOTION CARRIED.

COUNCIL MEMBER KLOCKER MOVED, COUNCIL MEMBER MARCHANT SECONDED a motion to allow Mayor Brooks to sign the contract with Ricchio Incorporation for a salvaged Whitewater Waterslide on the condition that Mr. Burbach write a letter stating that he has inspected the slide and it is in good working condition. All ayes, MOTION CARRIED.

COUNCIL MEMBER KLOCKER MOVED, COUNCIL MEMBER MARCHANT SECONDED a motion to pass Resolution 1, 2017-Official Depository, Resolution 2, 2017-Investment Policy and Resolution 3, 2017-Revised City Fees and Rate Schedules Dated January 3, 2017. All ayes, MOTION CARRIED.

Marty Noonan Chief of Police has approved the street closures for the 3rd Annual Sundance Winter Festival.

COUNCIL MEMBER KLOCKER MOVED, COUNCIL MEMBER MCLEAN SECONDED a motion to allow Mayor Brooks sign the Grant agreement with Wyoming Department of Transportation for the walking path grant. All ayes, MOTION CARRIED.

COUNCIL MEMBER KLOCKER MOVED, COUNCIL MEMBER MARCHANT SECONDED a motion to approve the Pledgee Agreement between the Federal Reserve Bank of Boston and the City of Sundance to secure the city's funds. All ayes, MOTION CARRIED.

COUNCIL MEMBER MARCHANT MOVED, COUNCIL MEMBER WILSON SECONDED a motion to follow the IRS Mileage Allowance and reduce the mileage rate to 53.5 cents per mile. All ayes, MOTION CARRIED.

Financial Disclosure Statements were handed out to the Mayor, Council and Office Staff to sign and return to Clerk Lenz.

COUNCIL MEMBER MARCHANT MOVED, COUNCIL MEMBER WILSON SECONDED a motion to approve ORDINANCE NO. 1, 2017-AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE UNIFORM ACT REGULATING TRAFFIC ON HIGHWAYS AND OTHER SECTIONS OF WYOMING LAW; PROVIDING FOR A COPY OF THE ACT TO BE ON FILE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE on its first reading. All ayes, MOTION CARRIED.

Fire Chief Chris Tomford reported that they have 1 new member and 3 new applicants.
