City Engineer Karla Greaser reported on the Cole transmission waterline and PRV projects. Trihydro has received comments from WDEQ on the permit to construct. Trihydro is hoping to get a response back to WDEQ by Thursday at the latest. The permit should be issued next week. They are still waiting on signatures for the M-54 permit from WYDOT. As soon as we get the permit we will be ready to advertise for bid.

Ms. Greaser sent a cost estimate and scope of work to Clerk Treasure Kathy Lenz this afternoon to do the design, prepare construction and bids for the walking path at the new elementary school.
