

November 9, 2017

The Town Council met this day at 5:30 p.m. to hold a special meeting with agenda items of Landfill Closure.

Mayor Brooks opened the meeting with Council members Klocker, Marchant, Wilson and McLean present. Also in attendance was Representative Lindholm, DEQ representative Craig McOmie, Public Works Director Mac Erickson, Clerk Treasurer Kathy Lenz. In the audience was Craig Hemmah, with C&A Meats, Cort Cundy with CW Waste, and Warren Crawford, DVM.

Discussion was held on the process of obtaining a Construction Demolition Waste permit from the Department of Environmental Quality now that the landfill is closed.

No official action was taken, but several plans to handle animal waste were discussed. One option is to build windrows made up of compost and dry the offal (liquid) from the animals until the matter was dry enough to be hauled to an open landfill. The other option is use the compost method until the animals had decomposed enough to be buried in the CDW pit when and if a permit is granted to the City. d

There being no more business before the council Mayor Brooks adjourned the special meeting at 7:30 p.m.
