It wasn't until I sold my previous business Carolton Farm and Fibers that I became interested in quilting. I have been an avid quilter now for sixteen years and a longarm quilter for twelve years.

I purchased my first **Gammill** longarm machine (stitch regulated for freehand work only) in 2004. I purchased my second **Gammill** longarm machine (with Statler Stitcher) in 2015. I am hooked and dedicated. I take pride in my workmanship and will take extra special care of your quilt while in my possession. Studio hours are by appointment only.

I pick-up and deliver to Cottonwood on the **first and third Mondays** of each month and can come most anytime by appointment. Remember I am only a telephone call away.

I operate my business on a first come, first serve basis.

I absolutely love starting a day in my studio with yet another beautiful quilt. I hope the next one will be yours.
