

## Celebrating Color Quilt 60" X 72"

I designed this quilt to showcase the Chroma collection by Deborah Edwards at Northcott. It uses 29 of the 30 fabrics in the collection. I chose to eliminate one of the dark red fabrics and use one of the purple fabrics for Group B Fabrics 2 and 4. (You will need one fat quarter or one 1/3 yard piece to cut enough for both blocks.) Notice that the frames around each block go from light to dark.

### Supplies:

- sewing machine
- thread to match each color group
- scissors, pins, and seam ripper
- recommend a ¼" foot
- chalk marker
- rotary cutter, ruler, and mat

### Fabric:

- 29 fat quarters from the Chroma Collection – see information above

If you are buying the fabric by the yard, buy ¼ yard each. However, Group A fabrics 2 and 4, Group B fabrics 1, 2, 4, and 5, Group E fabrics 1 and 5, and Group F fabrics 2 and 4 will need 1/3 yard each.

- batting – 66" X 78"
- backing – 3 2/3 yards
- binding – 5/8 yard – cut 7 – 3" X WOF strips
